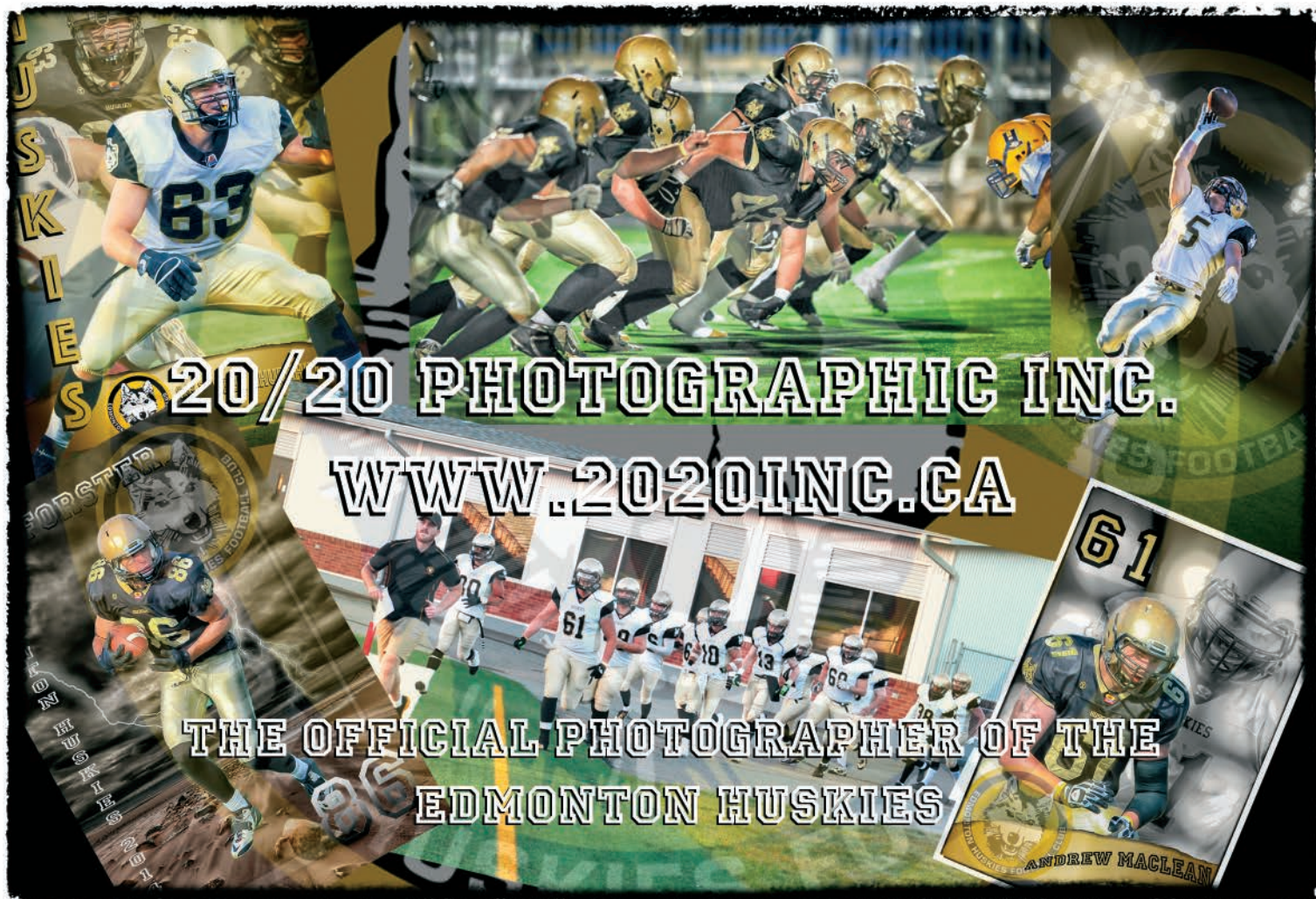
- **Creating a heightened interest in belonging to our Alumni Society**

A BAKER'S DOZEN + TWO

The first teams formed in junior football were in Ontario in 1883 with the Ontario Rugby Football Union forming in 1890. In 1907, The Canadian Rugby Football Union took control and dictated that the Canadian Championship would be decided by a game between the Ontario and Quebec Champions. The west, which was slower to get started, did see the first Western Canada Championship in 1917, in Regina. In 1925, the Regina Patricias travelled east and lost in the first truly Canadian final. The Alberta Junior Football League was formed in 1924. After a couple of false starts it became permanent in 1950. The Huskies came into being in 1954, taking over from the (believe it or not) Edmonton Oilers (commonly referred to as the South Side Oilers). The record book we work from spans more than a century of Junior Football in Canada.

Here are fifteen questions to test your knowledge of our own Edmonton Huskies history.

1. According to the old programs, how many players have worn the Huskies uniform in our 60 years?

11. A different pair of Huskies set the Canadian record for the longest pass in league play. Again, who did it, when and how far?
12. When Anthony Barrett signed a professional contract with the Eskimos this year he was following how many Huskies who signed previous contracts?
13. Which former Huskies had the longest professional career?
14. Which former Huskie is the Toronto Argonauts all time leading scorer?
15. A Huskies team made the second highest single game offensive yard total in the history of junior football. Not surprisingly the number of first downs made by that team in that game stands as an all time Canadian record. When, how many yards and how many first downs?
