President's Report (Alex Rogosheske)

- Refund Policy
 - Updated Refund Policy was sent out; no major changes; added additional clarification language; indicating that once Eval. 1 takes place; there will be no refunds; Player and Parent Handbook has been updated.
 - > There were a few players that quit this year, right after MYHA teams were rostered.
 - > Discussed that refunds will only be issued to players that make their HS team.
 - Look to add a separate JG policy for refunds; injuries are handled separately as a one off; parents will need to petition the board for any refund.
- **MOTION** made by Abe Appert to approve a pro-rated refund to any Bantam/U15 player who makes their high school team. Second by Krissy Wright. Unanimous. Motion passes.

 - ➤ Continue to support Quinny's & Forster's Dugout.

Vice President's Report (Abe Appert)

- DEC/Goalie Nets
 - Looking into cost of restringing the goal nets at the DEC; approx. \$1,000; could provide DIBS; it is more complicated than previously through; suggest we pay to have it done right.

- **MOTION** made by Abe Appert to approve \$1,000 to have the goalie nets at the DEC professional re-strung. Second by Tom Larson. Unanimous. Motion passes.
 - Will get a dumpster up to the DEC once it opens; Gene Wegleitner will provide it again free of charge.

Shed

- > Shed was broken into a couple months ago; did not take anything, mostly made a mess of it;
- > Jim Kirkwood is able to remove some of the Charitable Gambling documents; three shelves can be removed.
- > Discuss with the District if we can tear it down; build something else.

Finance/Budget

- ➤ Krissy e-mailed out the current summary of our Budget to Actuals earlier today:
 - As of today, MYHA has \$503k in cash in the bank;
 - \$55k of accounts payable which would reduce our cash balance to \$448k. We will continue to collect cash from registrations on payment plans.
 - Our budgeted remaining expenses are \$533k.

> Coach Expenses

- Pass years we have offered \$100 to head coaches; \$50 for assistant coaches for a credit to Lettermen's for apparel.
- Need to confirm total number of coaches registered; if we continue with one HC; two
 Assistants; meaning \$200/team we would be at \$3500 for the boys travel teams; probably \$1500 for girls traveling teams; and Mite/U6/U8
- \$11k in the budget for coaches reimbursement.
- MOTION made by Nate McClanahan to approve apparel credit of \$100 for one (1) Head coach and \$50 each for two (2) assistant coaches for the boys/girls traveling teams and Mite/U6/U8 teams. Second by Tim Boberg. Unanimous. Motion passes.

- Looking for JG16 Coaches yet; Alex advised that you reach out to parents on the team once they are set.

- Some discussion/rumors that there may be cuts at the JG levels; Nates recommendation is to do cuts; Alex advised that if there are any cuts; it would be board vote; can't make that decision until HS teams are formed; all JG registrations are finalized.

- Bantam Teams for the 2023-2024 Season
 - Five (5) Bantam teams: AA, B1, B2, B2, and C; 13-15 players per team.
 - All teams have head coaches; Bantam C Head coach position was not filed when teams were posted.
 - Normal amount of feedback form a few concerned parents; a few players did quit once rosters were posted.

PeeWee (Tom Larson)

- Evaluations
 - Five (5) PeeWee teams: AA, B1, B2, B2, and C; 13 players on each team
 - Everything went well; a few parents reached out; inquiring on the Evaluators feedback; what they can improve upon.
 - ➤ Parents attended the B2 practice session where they were finalizing the two balanced teams; need to close it off to parents going forward; a few had input and suggestions.
