#### **Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion**

Several resolutions regarding equity, diversity, and inclusion were carried at the 2022 AGM demonstrating the desire that the SHSAA Membership has toward Transformational Inclusion. The SHSAA continued to work with the Multicultural Council of Saskatchewan (MCoS) following the AGM to create videos, prepared for Districts, to reiterate "Why" the resolutions were needed for the Association to move toward Transformation Inclusion and providing suggestions for "How" to implement the changes in a positive manner.

#### New AD Webinar

SHSAA office staff hosted the second annual New AD Webinar in September. The turn-out of both new and experienced athletic directors was encouraging and the webinar was filled with sharing and information. #### **School Sport Week**

School Sport week was proclaimed by the Minister of Education from October  $9-15^{th}$ , 2022. The week was filled with activities across the province that culminated in a celebration of school sport during the Provincial Cross Country Championship hosted at the Wapiti Valley Ski Resort outside of Melfort. Over 30,000 students participate in school sport each year and this week recognizes the many students, coaches, and volunteers who make it possible.

#### **Remembrance Day**

The 2022 fall championship season coincided with Remembrance Day falling on a Friday. Through the cooperation of the Royal Canadian Legion, Saskatchewan Command, and our coaches, this weekend was not only a championship weekend but also an opportunity to reflect and pay respect to those who have served, and continue to serve our country, during times of war, conflict, and peace.



#### **Board of Directors Ad Hoc Committees**

Earlier this fall, Ad Hoc committees were formed by the Board of Directors regarding Sports Academies, Classification, Doubles Curling, and Program/Activity Review. Board Members are committed to reviewing activities and analyzing current topics to remain relevant and ensure Association values are met. The Ad Hoc Committees will continue their analyses throughout the school year.

#### **Strategic Planning**

The Board of Directors is engaging in Strategic Planning during the 2022-23 school year. With the guidance of an external facilitator, the Board Members are analyzing the Mission, Vision, Values, and Strategic Priorities of the Association. The new Strategic Plan is projected to be available to the Membership in the fall of 2023.

#### 12-aside Football Summit

In December, the Board of Directors and office staff engaged with Schools, School Divisions, and Districts that sponsor 12-aside football programs to have discussions and gain feedback regarding 12-aside football leagues and classification. The Board of Directors will be discussing the valuable information garnered from the Summit to prepare for the 2023 season.

#### **Sport Advisory Groups**

The Board of Directors finalized their committee members for the <a href="2022-23 Sport Advisory Groups">2022-23 Sport Advisory Groups</a>. Board Members will report at each Board meeting on the work being done by the Sport Advisory Group that they chair. Discussion amongst the groups will provide insight for the Board of Directors to consider in their planning for SHSAA. #### **Youth Officials**

The District Officials' Commissioners had a goal to offer basic officials' training virtually for Volleyball and Basketball starting during the 2022/23 school year. This was accomplished by hosting the First Annual Youth Officials Volleyball Clinic on September 8<sup>th</sup> which saw close to 300 attendees. ### SHSAA Coaches Card (2021-23) ABOUT THE CARD

The purpose of the SHSAA Coaches' Card is to show appreciation to those who volunteer their time for the students of Saskatchewan schools. The principal/athletic director will designate those eligible in the school but we suggest that the following be considered: school athletic coaches, school administrators, directors/superintendents of education, retired coaches, and other teachers active in the interschool program.

#### **CARD EXPIRY**

The Coaches' Card is valid for a period of TWO years. The 2019-2021 version (Yellow Card) expired as of August 31, 2021 and will not be accepted by the card sponsors. #### 2023 REGIONAL & PROVINCIAL CURLING

PRESENTED BY: Saskmilk

Each provincial championship will consist of eight teams scheduled as two pools of four teams in round-robin play format. The top two teams from each pool shall advance to the championship bracket. The eight teams participating at the provincial championships will include the host school and seven other teams that have qualified through the regional championships.

The tie-breaking criteria to determine placement in pool play and placement into tie-breaker games shall utilize the Skill Based Team Ranking System (SBTRS). For more information on the tiebreaker and the Saturday schedule of games please refer to the curling activity page of the SHSAA website.

Regional championships will be held March 3 - 4, 2023. The Regional championships will consist of a six or eight team double knock-out format leading to an 'A' event and 'B' event qualifier to the provincial championship. The only region that may require an A-B playoff to complete the double knock-out competition is the provincial host region. The A-B playoff will only be contested if the provincial host has not won either the 'A' or 'B' event. In the regions without an A-B playoff the 'A' event winner will be considered the Regional champion.

Districts should declare their representatives to the Regional Championships by Saturday, February 25, 2023 and contact the regional commissioners and SHSAA office following the competition.

Regional commissioners are asked to contact both the SHSAA office and provincial commissioner by Sunday, March 5, 2023 with the names of the schools and team members which have advanced to the provincial championship.

#### 2023 REGIONAL WRESTLING

**DATE:** Saturday, March 4, 2023

**LOCATION:** Carpenter High School (Meadow Lake)

COMMISSIONER: Kendra Paramchuk PHONE: 1-306-236-5236

#### **ENTRY:**

- All wrestlers from registered schools outside Regina and Saskatoon MUST attend this meet in order to qualify for the Provincial Tournament.
- 2. Registered schools may enter more than one wrestler per division.
- 3. Every participating school **MUST** contact the commissioner and SHSAA Office, with their intent to enter, and indicate the number of competitors by the Monday preceding the regional tournament. Competitors who have not been pre-registered by their coaches will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.
- 4. The Saskatchewan District team that advances to the Provincial Tournament will consist of up to four qualifiers from this meet per weight division.
- 5. The coaches present will select the "District" coaching staff (Head and Assistant Coach).
- 6. The District Coaches, in consultation with the commissioner, will select the final district team.

#### WEIGH-IN:

A weigh-in will not be held at the Regional tournament. Each wrestler must weigh in at their home school. A school administrator or their designate must certify the weight. Certified weights must be submitted to the host commissioner and SHSAA office by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on the Thursday preceding the meet (March 2, 2023). Note this procedure is used for the regional meet only.

#### **SKIN INSPECTIONS:**

Skin inspections will begin at 9:00 am. All participants must pass the on-site skin inspection before wrestling.

#### **START TIME:**

The tournament begins at 10:00 am. Three wrestling mats are available for matches.

#### **RULES FOR HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLING:**

#### **ENTRY:**

Regina, Saskatoon, and District rosters (top 6) must be declared, and entries received by the commissioner and SHSAA office on or before, Sunday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. Changes to original entries must be made by 9:00am on Tuesday, March 14<sup>th</sup>. Upon receiving district rosters, the SHSAA office will fill weight classes one spot at a time on a rotational basis as outlined by the 'Provincial Rotation'. Before a spot is officially filled, the athlete's coach will have final discretion. Substitutions by districts for their original entries may be made up to 12:00 noon on Thursday, March 16<sup>th</sup>.

#### **SKIN CHECKS:**
