Advisory Election Process for Executive Officers

The Directors of the British Columbia Minor Baseball Association herby undertake to elect the Executive Officers in accordance with the outcome of the Advisory Election of the membership.

The following process has been established to on how the Advisory Election will occur following the election the Board of Directors.

- 1. The elected Directors will confirm interest in being considered for the executive role in question by standing and confirming their name with the Secretary of the meeting.
- 2. For President, once the candidates are confirmed, candidates wishing to stand for election will be provided up to five (5) minutes to address the assembled members and present their platform for election.
- 3. For the other Executive Officer roles, should any election for these roles be required following the election for President (1st and 2nd Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary), any candidates wishing to stand for election will be provided up to two (2) minutes to address the assembled members and present their platform for election.
- 4. Members will then vote for the Executive Officer roles by secret ballot, which shall be collected by the Secretary of the Association.
- 5. Where two (2) or more candidates run for one position and where no candidate receives 50% + 1 of the votes, then the candidate with the lowest number of votes will be eliminated and the membership will vote again. This process will continue, until such time as a single candidate receives 50% + 1.
- 6. The results of the vote shall be announced to the attendees of the meeting and communicated to all membership by the usual process for communicating results of General Meetings of the membership of the Association.
