



## HRBBA Board Meeting Minutes

March 8, 2026

### Meeting Attendance

### President Report

- Motion to approve February Board Minutes. Motion passes.
- **Southwest League:** Andy will provide financial report. Tim should pay all invoices by Wednesday. Andy should advertise the need for a new League Coordinator with existing families as there is not interest from current board members.
- **Code of Conduct:** The group agreed to revisit the Code of Conduct at the next meeting and clarify coach expectations, particularly around enforcing behavior standards and potential playing-time consequences for violations. The board noted that school suspensions cannot be used as an enforcement mechanism because that information is protected.

### Rochester Tournament Debrief

- Overall, the event continues to be a highlight for many players and families. Positives included the popular 8th grade party, strong community-building among teams and families, and a well-run tournament format that allows teams to play 4–5 games against opponents they don't typically face.
- The primary concern raised was player, parent, and coach behavior. The association also received feedback from other programs that a Hopkins team was not behaving appropriately offsite during team activities.
- The board discussed whether the Rochester tournament should remain a mandated event for HRBBA teams, noting that other sports such as baseball sometimes allow teams to decide on a case-by-case basis. Several ideas were proposed to improve oversight and expectations, including:
  - Offering volunteer credits (Dibs) for hall monitors/rovers during the weekend
  - Exploring whether the existing check requirement could function more like a broader security deposit
  - Holding a mandatory parent and player meeting during practice before the tournament to review expectations
- As a next step, a Rochester-related question will be added to the season survey to gather feedback on whether families want to return. The board will use that input to determine if Rochester should be a mandated tournament next year.

- In the meantime, Sara will place a verbal hold on the hotel for next year while the board continues evaluating options.
