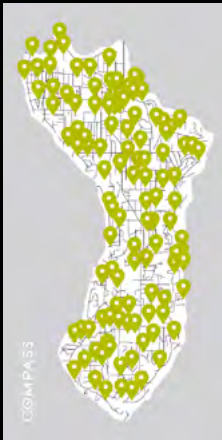

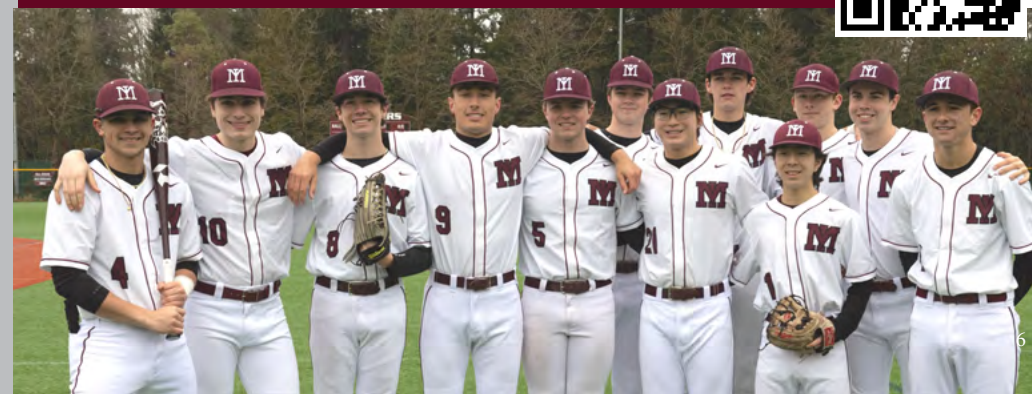

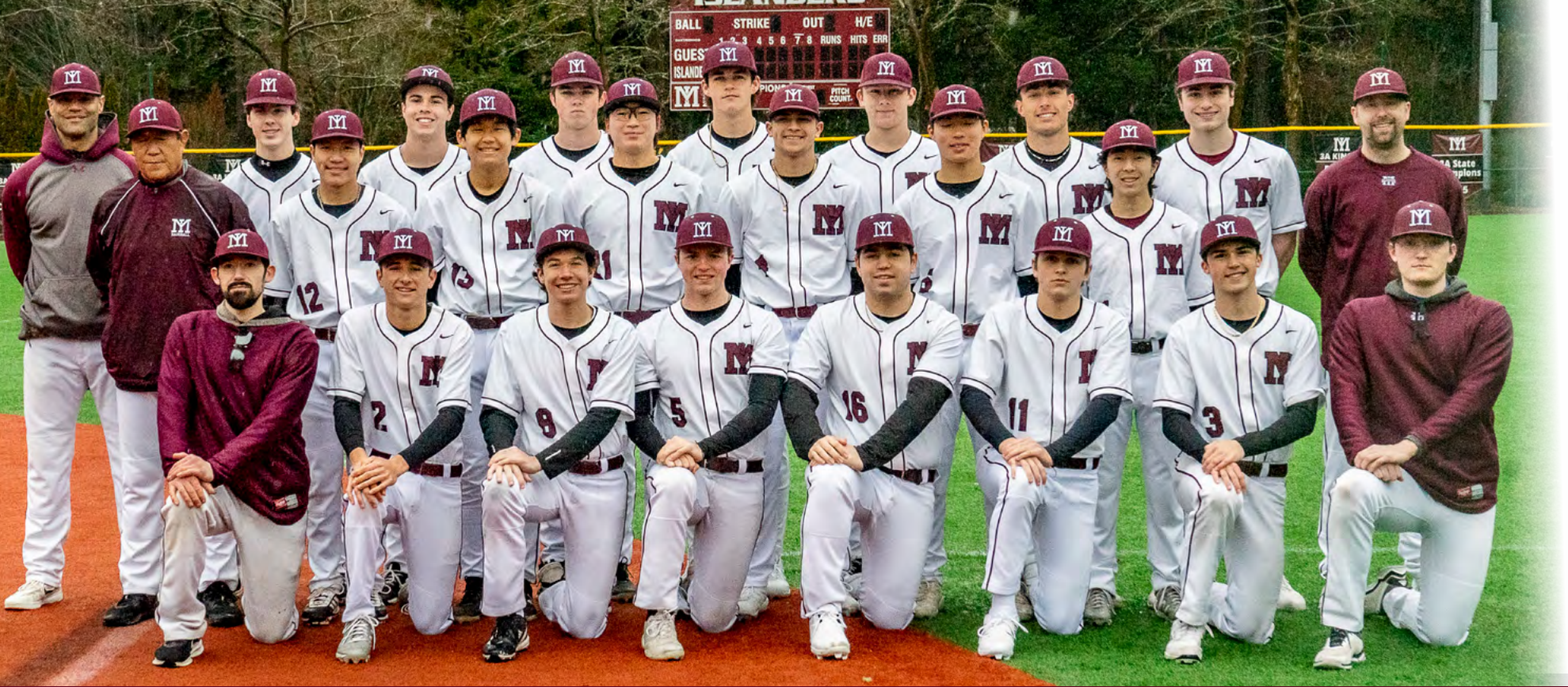

## DOMINIC WOODY – Varsity Head Coach

Coach Dominic Woody was named MIHS head coach in 2013. He has led the Islanders to two WIAA 3A State Titles in 2022 and 2015, four KingCo titles in 2016-2019, a 3rd place 3A State finish in 2017, and in 2014, 2016 and 2017 he was honored as the KingCo “Coach of the Year.” As a player at Richland High School, Woody helped lead his team to the District and Regional Championships. Woody was part of Pac-10 Championship and NCAA Regional teams at the University of Washington. He set single-season Husky records for HRs and RBIs. Woody was selected First Team All-Pac-10 Catcher and 3rd Team All-American Collegiate Baseball. In 1999, Woody was drafted in the 4th round by the Florida Marlins. In the minor leagues he was part of 2001 Midwest League Championship team. Woody played six seasons of professional baseball including time with the Seattle Mariners and Los Angeles Angels organizations. He also served as the Seattle Mariners bullpen catcher in 2006. When not coaching, Woody throws bp to his kids Enzo & Otto while his wife Angie tracks pitch counts.



## MI COACHING STAFF

### BRET DEROOY – Varsity Assistant Coach



Coach Bret joined the Mercer Island Baseball coaching staff in 2015 and helped lead them to their first 3A State Championship and another

state championship in 2022. He graduated from Woodinville High School where he was a 3x Letter Winner in Baseball '07, '08, and '09. He was also named 2x All Metro 2nd Team Pitcher in '08 and '09. He currently holds the Woodinville High School record for career and single season strikeouts as well as the single game strikeout record 2019 vs. Eastlake. He pitched for Washington State University for 3 seasons and then transferred to Campbellsville University for the final two years of his collegiate career. After college, in 2013 he played in the Picos Independent league.

### JOSH PATTERSON – JV Head Coach



Coach JP has been coaching for Mercer Island baseball since 2016. He spent five years prior as the Head JV Coach at Juanita High School in Kirkland and the year prior as assistant coach for

Eastlake High School in Sammamish. JP has been a Head Coach in the Seattle Elite League since 2011 with the 13U Club Nine Baseball for three seasons. He is the current coach for the

14U Baden Baseball team. JP played ball at Thomas Jefferson in Federal Way and was an All-League South Puget Sound League (SPSL) pitcher. He pitched for Olympic College before transferring to Central Washington University. He joined the Puget Sound Senior Baseball League (PSSBL) where he continues to pitch. Baseball has always been a focal point and drive in JP's life whether it be the passion for the game or the lessons it can bring to everyday life.

### KENNY TERHUNE – JV Assistant Coach

Coach Kenny began coaching at Mercer Island High School in 2018, after starting with the Baden 16U team in 2017. He works at Verizon as an Engineer, designing and permitting construction projects that bring fiber optics to wireless equipment. Kenny graduated from Woodinville High School in '09 and played middle infield for Woodinville Baseball Club from 2002-2009. He was part of a state championship team in 2002 and received the most All-Star votes in the league the year prior. In Kenny's free time, he enjoys golfing, basketball, snowboarding, diving, playing in rec softball or baseball leagues, and taking his Bernese Mountain Dog “Gracie” on hikes or to the park.



### PAUL SUGURO – C-Team Head Coach

Coach Paul joined the MIHS baseball coaching staff in 2017. Paul's primary responsibility is coaching the C-Team, along with assisting the JV and Varsity teams. Paul's coaching experience goes back a long time. Paul coached baseball at his alma mater, Cleveland High School, and football at Chief Sealth High School. Paul also coached with the Rips Brewers and Baden baseball organizations. Paul's son Michael played catcher for the University of Hawaii at Hilo. Paul and his wife Nancy reside in West Seattle.



### TROY PETERSON – C-Team Assistant Coach

Coach Troy joined the MIHS baseball coaching staff in 2022. Previously, Troy was the head JV coach with Bellevue High School with his first year being in 2016 as the head C-Team Coach, where he led the team to a successful 12-5 season. Troy is a 2010 Interlake High School Alum and a 3-year letterman on the mound. He also played under the tutelage of Pete Wilkinson at the Wilkinson Academy. Following High School, Peterson played two seasons of college baseball for Green River Community College. Peterson was named most outstanding pitcher attending a Tom House pitching camp, with House widely considered the “Father of Modern Pitching Mechanics.” Coach Troy is also the 14U coach with the Eastside Huskies Baseball Club, and has spent most of his life in the game of baseball. He enjoys sharing his passion for the game and pitching expertise with avid ballplayers.



### GARRETT POORE – Assistant Coach

Garrett is a lifelong Islander and a 2018 MIHS grad. He played on the 2017 3rd place Islanders State team and on the 2018 KingCo Champion team. Baseball has been a vision his whole life. He was a bullpen catcher during his time at Texas Christian University and is currently looking to transfer and play with another college.
