Subject: Deadline extended for Player Recommendation Process for TOLD

The Ontario Soccer High Performance Program has extended the date for coaches to submit their player recommendations for the 2019 Talent on Location Day for 2006, 2005 and 2004 born players from July 2 to the new closing date of July 7 at 5:00 p.m.

The player recommendation process for Technical Staff of District Member Clubs and Ontario Registered Academies appears on the [Ontario Soccer Website in the High Performance, Player Talented Pathway section](#).

This will allow players in Ontario to have the opportunity to be recommended by a certified and qualified Club, Academy Head Coach or Technical Director.

In order to be considered as a qualified and certified coach, the coach must have a minimum of a Provincial B Licence / Canadian National B Licence Part 1 Certified Status or a foreign equivalency. Submissions from non-qualified or certified coaches (i.e. Canadian National B Licence Part 1 Trained) will not be considered.

Before beginning the process, it is highly recommended that the coach, player and parent read and understand the information bulletin on the Recommendation Process: [I2017-028](#) that appears on the Ontario Soccer Website in the High Performance, Player Talented Pathway section.

The recommending coach will then complete the Coach Information page and provide their NCCP and Ontario Soccer registration numbers to verify their coaching certification level and status. If no NCCP number (i.e. foreign license) is available, please provide a scanned copy of the Coaching Certificate as outlined on the page.

The recommending coach, will then be directed to watch ten minutes of Provincial Teams' game film.

The recommending coach should note the jersey number of the Ontario Provincial Player whom they believe their recommended player(s) is the equivalent of or better than. The coach will then download and complete the appropriate player evaluation form for each individual player being recommended. Once completed, the document will be uploaded as prompted on the page.

The Recommending coach should have the following available:

- Player's name
- Player's date of birth
- Player's Ontario Soccer number
- Player's email(s) contact

The recommending coach is to submit the completed online package by, or before, the closing date of July 7, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

The Ontario Soccer High Performance Program will review the player recommendation packages and assess if the player should receive an invite. Player recommendation packages submitted using the online process will be the only ones that will be reviewed. Incomplete or inaccurate packages will not be considered for review.

The High Performance Program will contact those players and the recommending coach if they have been invited to the upcoming Talent on Location Day Event:
