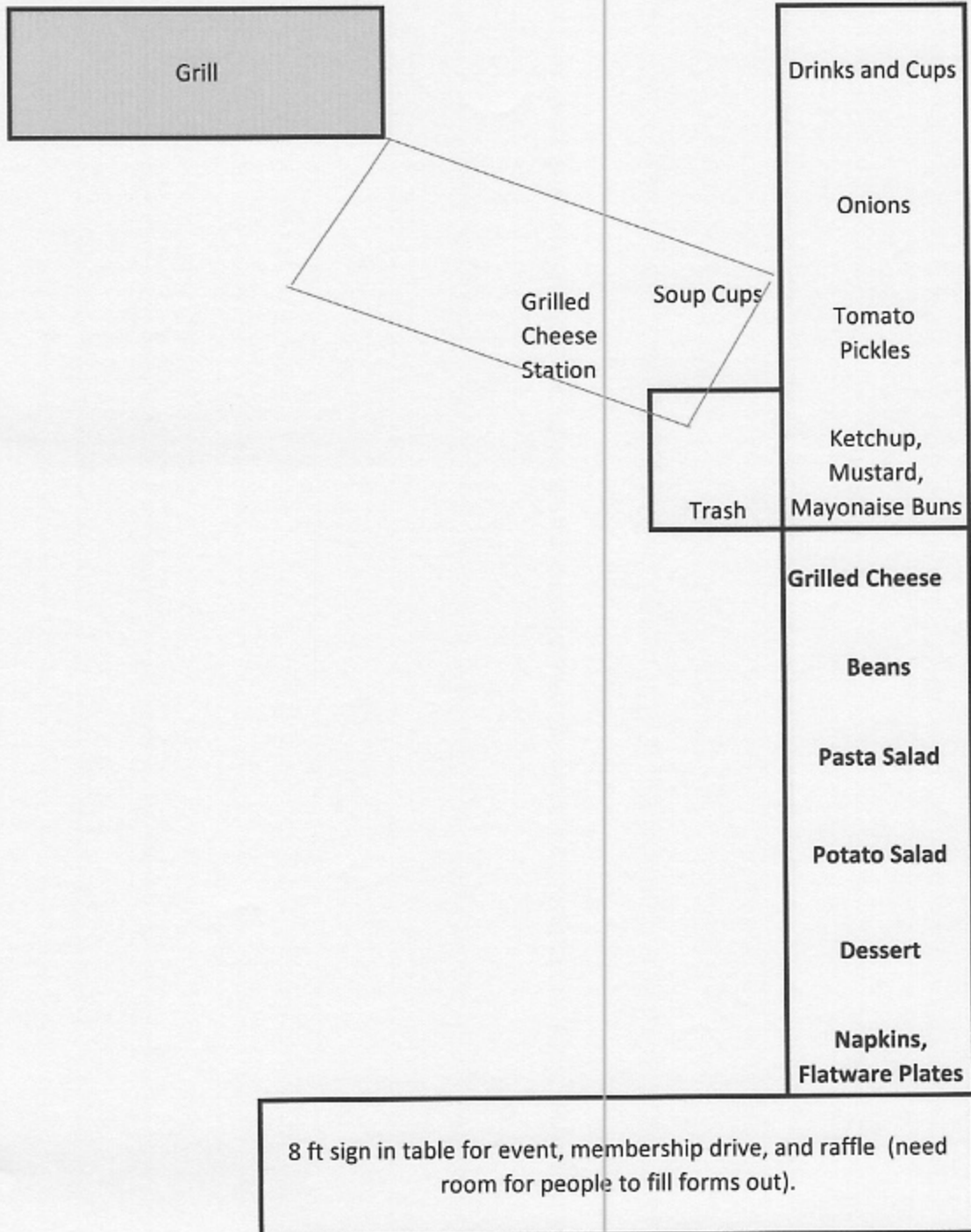

It looks like more than 135 people attended. Looks like 34 new members joined. At the end I think there were just 4 hotdogs left.

Discussed scope of event, Bogus Basin Ski Club Day at Bogus (End of Season Party/BBQ).

Date Sunday, March 23rd 12 noon – 4pm.

Logistics: Approved by JJ, Set up is located on parking lot, next to the Pioneer Lodge, across from BBSEF office. Area is easy access to BB amenities & great visibility to membership and general public. Cones will be set up 7:30am by JJ, to designate our set up space. It is recommended that as a group to come and begin set-up shortly after that time, due to public parking can minimize the space that we would need.

Food & Beverage: JJ approved plan for BBQ with a few requirements. Non alcohol beverages are permitted. Alcohol beverages must be purchased through Bogus Basin. Contact: Mo, food/bev. Mngr 208.392.8246. JJ liked the idea of charging non-members for their food, in support of a 'non-compete' focus.

Entertainment: Music entertainment is welcomed.

BBSC 'Fun Slush' Race Course: Charlie Russell – Coordinator JJ approved and will support a dual course, set up on the 'Ridge' under the lift on the front side, down from Deerpoint. Bogus will provide man-power to monitor the course, along with our volunteers. Charlie will provide volunteer schedule/requirements of the event. Scope of the event: "Learn to Turn" not timed, short course & free to general public. All ages, shapes, speeds and styles are welcome. A hold harmless waiver will be required from

Participants and will be managed by Bogus Basin staff at the race start.

Marketing & Promotions: Kim Hovren – Coordinator. Please submit outline of event details to me ASAP. I will prepare them for Constant Contact. JJ will support our event through Bogus Basin social media channels: FaceBook & a media – blast. A flyer/poster will be accepted and posted in the lodges through JJ.

Other Requirements: For the day of event, BBSC is required to have an 'event – hold harmless Bogus Basin' waiver coordinated with our insurance provider. A copy to be given to JJ McLeod.

Other Recommendations: JJ offered ideas that we can consider: 1) Fire Pit – draws in people 2) Ski hosts (show the mountain) – offers interaction with members & public. 3) Scavenger hunt
