Philosophy



Playing Time

- Balanced (not necessarily equal) playing time is to be dictated as much by commitment and attendance as skill level.
- Development of players, particularly at the younger age levels and lower tiers, is valued over a winning record.
- U10-U12: each player should learn and play several positions.



USA / MN SOFTBALL REGISTRATION



• All HFC players (U14 & under) are required to be registered with USA/MN Softball to participate in league and tournament play. If your daughter has played HFC in the last 2 years you likely have a player(family) profile and account. If not you will need to register for one. Once registered, the player's birth certificate will then need to be uploaded for compliance purposes. Fielders Masks

- U10-U14: Must wear in the infield, encouraged in the outfield
- Recommended to have own for sanitary reasons
 - Court Sports metal version

Helmets

- Black OR White w/royal helmets preferred
- Personal helmets recommended for sanitary reasons

* Team equip bags will have a few extra helmets and fielders masks

Parent Reps



- <u>Liaison between coach and parents</u>
 - Each team will have a volunteer parent rep
 - Parent Rep assignment equilibrates as 3 DIBs volunteer hours
- Responsibilities as designated by the Coach (varies)
 - Examples may include:
 - Communicate with coach on tasks required
 - Assist in distributing uniforms, sock orders, picture forms, etc.
 - Coordinate collection of player documentation or fees (sock fees, etc)
 - Distribute tournament info to players/parents as soon as it is available
 - Arrange team bonding/building events
 - Aid in car-pool arrangements if needed.
- Parent Rep is NOT an assistant coach, not involved in any coaching related decisions

Parent Conduct



Parent Roles

- Support players and coaches
- Positive encouragement, constructive feedback
- Accept decisions by umpires and coaches

• 24-Hour Rule

- Coaches will not discuss game situations with parents/grandparents/adults until at least 24 hours after the game.
- Strongly encourage player being part of all conversations.

Parent/Adult Misconduct – Consequences

- Asked to leave the event
- Written warning
- Second offense, banned for the season

 - 6 volunteer hours or family max of 12. Forfeit deposit if hours not worked.
