- Most Scholarships are not full rides (Mostly earned at the FBS level)
- The Lower the Division the fewer scholarships they have. (FBS 85, FCS, 63, D2 36, D3 0, NAIA 24)
- It is all about timing



Academics

- Grades are important
- Grades help pay for school (Especially lower divisions)
- I recommend always aim for 3.0
- Sign up for the NCAA Clearinghouse/NAIA Clearinghouse
- SAT & ACT are no longer required, but I do recommend



MAKING THE GRADE

The % of College and Universities that can recruit you based on your CORE GPA.

4.0 GPA = 94% of Schools 3.5 GPA = 72% of Schools 3.0 GPA = 51% of Schools 2.5 GPA = 21% of Schools 2.0 GPA = 8% of Schools The other key factor will be; does the college coach believe you can play and help their program. HOW DO YOU MEASURE UP?



Recruiting Calendar Periods

- **Quiet Period** In peron recruiting on college campus only. No in person recruiting off-campus.
- **Dead Period** Means what it sounds like. No in person recruiting allowed on or off campus. College coaches usually do no recruiting at all during this time.
- **Evaluation Period** In person and off campus recruiting is allowed but they aren't allowed to make contact with student-athlete.
- **Contact Period-** Colleges are allowed to make in person, off campus recruiting contacts and evals.
