## Jamboree Rules

1. Mite (8u) Games- 4-on-4 with Goalie following USA hockey's half- ice format.  
Termites (6u) games 4-on-4 without a Goalie following USA hockey's cross-ice format
2. All USA Hockey rules will apply except as modified below. All teams, coaches and players must be registered with **USA Hockey**. USA hockey equipment requirements will be followed which includes mouth guards to be worn.
3. **Length of games:**
  - Games will start with a 3 minute warm-up.
  - Games will consist of two 18 minute run time periods with 1 minute breaks in between
  - The buzzer will sound every 3 minutes for line changes. Referees will drop the puck every 3 minute revolution to make sure appropriate line changes are performed
  - After goals, the referee will retrieve the puck from the net and throw the puck off to the side to allow the kids to get the play going quickly again. Please have the scoring team back off and back up for the ref to toss in the corner
  - When the goalie has a save and covers the puck, the referee will blow the whistle and then immediately throw the puck to a corner to quickly resume play. Please have the opposing team of the goalie that covered it back off and back up for the ref to toss in the corner.
  - The scoreboard will only show a 5 goal differential. Since this is a Jamboree, no official score will be kept.
4. **Penalties-** Following the cross-ice officiating guide, play will continue for minor infractions. For a more severe infraction that involves an injury potential action, the referee may stop play quickly to assess the penalty. If a penalty is called the player called will need to leave the ice, allowing the coach to address the player, but the team will remain at full strength. No penalty shot will be utilized
5. **Jerseys:** Team listed 1st on the schedule will be the visiting team (the visiting team wears dark). Coaches may check with the other team if jersey switch is needed or possible.

6. **Protests:** The Tournament Director or Representatives will be present for all questions or inquiries. The Tournament Director or Representative will uphold all on-ice officiating.
7. **Sportsmanship:** Fighting, abusive behavior or unsportsmanlike conduct by players, team officials or spectators will not be tolerated, either on or off the ice. This will be grounds for removal of the tournament and from the property of Centennial Ice Arena. The referees shall have the option of ending any game should they feel that the players or the officials are in danger. In such cases the Tournament Director or Representative and/or ice officials will determine the outcome of the game.
8. **Rink and Facilities:** Should any player, team or spectator damage any property within Centennial Ice Arena, they will be responsible for all costs associated with repair or replacement. Such behavior will also be grounds for dismissal from the tournament and the property of Centennial Ice Arena. Air Horns are not permitted in the arena.
