- The Steel earned a point in the standings for the fifth consecutive game but fell 4-3 in a shootout against Team USA (U18) on Saturday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena ... Chicago went 1-for-5 (20.0%) on the power play ... The Steel penalty kill unit enjoyed a 4-for-4 (100%) performance including a shorthanded goal ... Chicago outshot Team USA, 32-24 including a 14-5 edge in the third period ... The Steel have now played 13 games that required extra time, the most in the USHL ... Chicago owns a 6-3 record in overtime and a 2-2 mark in shootouts.
- Sean Farrell tied the Steel single-season points mark with a goal and a helper. The Montreal Canadiens prospect now has 82 points (25G, 57A) in 44 games played, tying **Andrew Miller** (Steel 2007-2009) who registered 82 points (32G, 50A) in 58 games during the 2008-2009 campaign.
- **Erik Middendorf** added his 27th goal of the season, the second-most in the USHL during the 2020-2021 season.
- Steel rookie **Adam Fantilli** scored his 11th goal of the year, giving the Nobleton, Ontario native 27 points (11G, 16A).
- Jack Babbage, Ian Moore and Jack Bar added helpers in the loss.
- Netminder Simon Latkoczy made 20 saves through regulation and overtime.
