
- www.EligibilityCenter.org
- Register Before June Of Junior Year
- Coach Brewer Will Submit Transcripts After Junior Year
- You Will Submit Test Scores For Verification ACT Code 9999
- Confirm Amateur Status
- Required To Attend "Official Visits" Senior Year.
 - School Pays For Travel, Lodging, Meals
- \$90 Fee (Coach Brewer Can Tell You If You Qualify For A Waiver)

ACADEMICS – CORE COURSES


- NCAA Eligibity Center Calculates GPA Using Only "Core Courses"
- English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Additional (Language)
 - Not all classes are approved by the NCAA
 - Intro Algebra, Astronomy, Outdoor Education
 - World Religions is only "Core" approved religion class
- Graduation From CDH Typically Satisfies "Core Course" Credit Requirement
- ► Each Trimester = .34 Credits
- No +/- Consideration (A=4 Points, B=3 Points, C=2 Points)

 - FINANCIAL HELP AVAILABLE!
- Test Early To Identify Weaknesses (Feb Junior Year)
- ACT Pre-Test Taken As Sophomore Is Strong Predictor Of Initial ACT Score


