Position Summary:

As a founding member of the Ontario Player Development League (OPDL) and a League1 Ontario License Holder, North Toronto Soccer is committed to providing players with access to the highest level of competition in Ontario. Our program, known as The Talented Pathway consists of OPDL (U13 - U17), League1 U20's, League2, and League1 Premier teams for both genders.

The primary responsibility of this position will be to assist one of the League1 Ontario teams within North Toronto Soccer's Talented Pathway. The Assistant Coach will be responsible for assisting all aspects of player and team development in accordance with North Toronto Soccer's Training Methodology and Game Model.

The team trains four (4) times and typically play in one (1) match per week from April - July which equates to approximately 8 hours per week on field. Training and Home games are located at Downsview Park.

Primary Duties & Responsibilities:

- Assist with the planning and execution of training sessions in line with North Toronto Soccer's Game Model, Tactical Identity, and Training Methodology
- Support games in an Assistant Coach capacity
- Providing player feedback
- Liaise with the Club's Medical support staff to ensure injuries and tracked and the correct return-to-play protocols are adhered to
- Maintaining good communication with players and coaches
