Want to know what to expect at Assessments?

Let's be honest, the word "assessment" can be a daunting term for even the most experienced player. But that is NOT what this day is about. This is NOT a tryout, but instead a time for coaches to evaluate and make a game plan for the most successful season they can have.

Players will participate in 2 main assessments: fielding and hitting. They will get the opportunity to catch pop fly's, throw to various bases as well as hit off of the pitching machine and run the bases/slide. They will not be asked to do anything they are uncomfortable doing, so if your player is not yet sliding, do not worry! Our goal is for the girls to walk away from assessments feeling great and ready to play ball!
