

## Facility Guidelines – 11.18.20 *Sporting Fields + Athletics*

(11.18.20) – The below Facility Guidelines go into effect at 12:01AM on Friday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, and will remain in effect until further notice.

### Requirements:

- Spectating shall be limited to one parent/guardian per player inside the facility.
- All individuals are required to wear a mask covering the nose and mouth, including players while physically active.
  - Players should always wear masks, even while playing on the field.
  - All visitors should wear masks throughout their time at the facility.
  - See reference articles below for exceptions and more information.
- Social distancing must take place off the field. This includes players and coaches on the sidelines.
- Each renting organization must abide by its insurance provider's return to play guidelines. Insurance providers may include Kansas Youth Soccer, US Club Soccer, USSSA, etc.

### Recommendations:

- Continue to follow proper precautions (i.e. wash/sanitize hands, stay home if sick, avoid touching of face, wear a mask, etc.).
- Do not share sports equipment.
- Vulnerable populations should be asked to stay home.
