VAA format – play 2 days a week, and coaches are encouraged to have practices prior to games, so families are only committing 2 nights, rather than 3 nights. Discuss possibility of eliminating middle school level rec soccer, due to difficulty getting teams together, coach volunteers, and need to send these teams out to other leagues for play.

Marketing – discussion of finding a way to market as a cities/state level club to attract players/families looking for that level of play/commitment and keep teams more stable.
