

League Details - F5 Futsal 2023-24 Winter League

Format- There will be one winter session consisting of a guaranteed 8 games plus playoffs. The season will run from Nov 17 to Jan 21.

Dates- Games will be played primarily on Saturdays, with limited games on Fridays and Sundays.

Teams have the option during registration to select two (2) conflict weekends for the session to block from being scheduled. There will be no league games played the weekend of Jan 12-15 as we will be hosting the US Youth Futsal South Atlantic Regional Championship. All playoff games will be played the weekend of Jan 19-21. Playoffs will include the top 4 teams in each division and consist of semifinals and finals.

Weekend schedule- Games will be scheduled primarily on Saturdays 8am-10pm. Fridays* (5-10pm) and Sundays (8am-1pm) may be utilized based on league registration. *Additional time on Fridays, Nov 24, Dec 22 & Dec 29 may be utilized, if needed.

Venues- The primary venue for the league will be Carolina Futsal Development Center, 2822 Commerce Drive, Rock Hill, SC. Additional venues in the Rock Hill/Fort Mill area may be utilized if additional court space is required.

Referee fees- The game referee fees are included in the team registration fee. All divisions will be officiated by a single referee.

Time keeper- The home team is responsible for providing a time keeper (14+ years old) at each game.

Coaches- There is no coaching license required to coach a team. Any adult who is registered with the team as a coach or manager can sit on the bench. This is a great option for teams with outdoor coaches who want to take a break, but still want their teams to have fun and play. All registered coaches and managers must complete SafeSport training and an annual background check (\$10) through USYF.

Coaches with multiple teams- We will accommodate coaches with multiple teams by scheduling them with back-to-back games at the same facility, as much as possible. We have been very successful in the past, so we encourage you to split your outdoor teams into two futsal teams.

Sister Teams- A sister team is created from an outdoor team that split into two or more futsal teams. If you have a sister team in the league, you may borrow any amount of players from the sister team for regular league games, but only officially rostered players may play in any and all playoff games. Ex. An Outdoor U10 team with 12 players would roster 6 players on each sister team. All 12 players are available to play for each team for any game, even playing with both teams on the same day. Only for the playoffs (semis and finals), would the players be limited to the 6 rostered players for that team.

Dual-rostered players- Players may be dual-rostered on teams that are in different divisions. Players may not play for more than one team in a division, except in the case of sister teams.
