



Return to Hockey Policy

- Pegula Ice Arena will continue to offer private ice rentals for select user groups only.
- We will be taking pre-registrations for ice time at this time. No spectators, fans, or parents will be permitted in the facility during our current phase of reopening. Players age 10 and under as well as those who need special assistance may be accompanied by ONE parent. Parents are required to follow all the same rules and regulations and will be asked to stay in a designated area or leave the facility.
- **Masks are required at our facility at all times.**
- **Our new policies and procedures will be enforced at all times.** Any patrons that do not follow our new policies will be asked to leave the facility. Policies and procedures will be on our website and posted throughout the facility.
- **Rigorous cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting procedures are now in place.** Employees will be disinfecting high touch areas between each ice session. All employees will be wearing appropriate personal protective equipment during their shifts. Each player will be assigned a personal station to get their skates on/off and employees will disinfect entire station after each use.
- **Players, Parents and Coaches are required to follow our new guidelines.**

Return to the Hockey Guidelines

Players

- If you have a fever or are not feeling well stay home.
- Must arrive fully dressed ready to put skates on and step on the ice.
- Must wear a facemask at all times in the facility including your time on the ice.
- Wash your hands thoroughly and utilize hand sanitizing stations whenever possible.
- Bring your own water bottle and do not share. With name on it, fill at home.
- Practice social distancing – 6ft apart from others.

Coaches

- If you have a fever or are not feeling well stay home.
- Wash your hands thoroughly and utilize hand sanitizing stations whenever possible.
- Must wear a facemask at all times in the facility including your time on the ice.
- Practice plans/drills should maintain social distancing on the ice.

- Notify and reinforce the message that players and coaches need to observe physical distancing recommendations while on the ice
- Utilize non-contact drills.
- When leaving the ice, coaches could excuse players one-by-one giving appropriate time for each player to get off the ice. Coaches need to plan to leave an appropriate amount of time at the end of their ice session to complete the dismissal process.

Parents

- Take your child's temperature before coming to the rink, stay home if there is a fever or they are not feeling well.
- Must wear a facemask at all times in the facility.
- Notify the rink if your child becomes sick or has a fever.
- Pack your child a water bottle. Put name on their water bottle, filled at home.
- Drop off/Pick up your children at the Gate C circle.
- 1 parent can accompany a child 10 and under or those who need special assistance.

Phases of Programming Reopening

Phase 1 – Private ice rentals for select user groups – September 7th

- No more than 25 pre-registered players/coaches during an ice slot
- List of those attending submitted by 5 PM the day before ice slot

Phase 2 – Private ice rentals – participants raised to 20% of ice capacity – November 22nd

- No more than 60 pre-registered players during a session
- List of those attending submitted by 5 PM the day before ice slot

What to Expect When Attending

(Players and Parents MUST read all information)

- Players will wait outside in their vehicles until 15 mins before their schedule session. Do not be late.
- Players are required to be fully dressed in full hockey gear
 1. Face mask is required
 2. No parents, fans, friends, spectators
 3. Children 10 and under or those who need special assistance may be accompanied by ONE parent. Parent must also practice social distancing from others (not from child) and wear a face mask.
- Players will use hand sanitizer before checking in at welcome desk.
- Welcome desk host will provide them with their assigned changing area. Players are to walk DIRECTLY to their area. No socializing, loitering or wandering.
- Once Players are at their area, they should begin putting on their skates.
- Players are to wait in their assigned area until the time of their ice slot.

1. Players must leave any and all items in their area that cannot be worn on their body the entire time they are on the ice (including skate guards, water bottles are ok, no items on boards).
 - When the session is over, players will exit off the ice and back to their personal changing area, keeping social distance.
 - Players will have 15 minutes to get skates off and leave the facility.
