SCORE – All families with travel age skaters should have received an email inviting them to participate in our SCORE event. Report cards must be submitted by March 7<sup>th</sup> so gifts can be ordered. The SCORE event is scheduled for March 15<sup>th</sup> from 1-3pm at the rink.

Also, only the designated locker room monitors/coaches are allowed in the locker room, so please remind guests that they can see your skater in the lobby before and after their game.
