
Player Conduct Waiver 2025



📵 For the purpose of this document, "League Authorities" refers to the current committee selected and directed by Joe Wilkinson.

- 1. League fees are due at the beginning of the season. Failure to pay will result in a forfeit for the team using any players that have not paid.
- 2. Rosters are due to the League Authorities one (1) week before the start of a new season. Rosters must consist of AT LEAST eight (8) players.
- 3. Substitute players must pay the sub fee before participating in the game. Failure to pay will result in a forfeit for the team using the substitute player(s).
- 4. Substitute players must be approved by **both** team captains before the game.
- 5. Teams must have at least four rostered skaters and a goaltender, or five rostered skaters and no goaltender, to begin a game. Failure to have the required number of players at the designated start time for the game will result in a forfeit.
- 6. All players must have a like-colored jersey with legible numbering on the back. No duplicate numbers are allowed.
- 7. League fees and substitute fees are **non-refundable**.
- 8. Rostered players must compete in at least three (3) regular season games to be eligible for playoffs.
- 9. There is a zero tolerance policy for fighting, both on and off the rink. Any fighting that occurs inside the facility or in the parking lot will result in an indefinite suspension pending a review from League Authorities.
- 10. There is a zero tolerance policy for abuse of game officials and rink staff. Any abusive conduct, language, or gestures that occur inside the facility, in the parking lot, or on any form of social media will result in an indefinite suspension pending a review from League Authorities.
- 11. Major penalties and game ejections that occur in a game will be reviewed by League Authorities for further disciplinary action.
- 12. Any individual found to be in possession of lost or stolen property shall be banned from the facility.
- 13. Alcohol is to be allowed ONLY in the locker rooms and parking lot. Any alcohol that is visible in common areas (spectator area, benches, rink, concession area, etc.) will be removed by rink staff.
- 14. Any form of vandalism will result in an indefinite ban from the facility pending a review from League Authorities. This includes, but is not limited to, intentional damage to the general seating area, locker rooms, players bench areas, floor tiles, boards, and glass.

а	the conclusion of each game, all players are required to shake hands with the opposing team. Failure to do so will result in one-game suspension. Additionally, any form of misconduct in the handshake line will result in a minimum of a one-game ispension.
