The IRONKIDS Luxembourg – Région Moselle is an Aquathlon (Swim & Run) and will be held on **Saturday June 18th, 2022 at 11:00am** in Remich. The swim takes place in the outdoor pool in Remich, the finish line will be the same as for the IRONMAN-race on Sunday.

Every participant will receive an IRONKIDS Finisher T-Shirt and an IRONKIDS medal. Additionally, the first three kids of each category will receive a certificate, and the winner of every age group will also receive a trophy.
