Club Philosophy

Northwest Juniors VBC began in 1972 and celebrated 50 years in 2022. Our mission is to provide opportunities for athletes to train and play the great sport of volleyball. Our club is committed to providing opportunities for young athletes at all levels of development to engage in quality, competitive experiences. We are dedicated to the idea that any athlete, regardless of size or skill level, who wants to participate in the USAV Junior Volleyball program, should be given the opportunity. We recognize many of our athletes' desire is to prepare for the possibility of high school volleyball. Our priority is to continue to develop our athletes by focusing on skill development to help them advance towards their goal. For most age groups, we offer three teams with a competition schedule to challenge and provide opportunities for success. Team descriptions are posted on the landing page of our Girls Club tab for review prior to registering before our tryout.

NW Juniors is a year-round club providing athletes the opportunity to advance their skills by training at NW Juniors Beach facility (also known as Bottega). We host national-level, and regional beach volleyball events. Our beach volleyball training is offered April-August. **NW Juniors members get discounts for our indoor and beach summer programming.

Tournament -Team schedules (https://www.nwjuniors.org/teams-schedules)

NW Juniors provides a competitive tournament schedule for our teams; giving the best opportunity to play competitive matches and grow as a team, and as an individual. *Practice schedules are set mid-November once ALL of our teams are formed*. *Our tournament schedule* requires major commitments for all teams. Dates are listed so players and families can plan for important competition dates. Important; if you are selected for and accept a position on a #1 U12-U14 team, these tournaments take priority over other activities and you should enter them into your schedules as such. Financial penalties exist for missing major tournaments like qualifiers and nationals. Tournament dates are subject to change once Qualifiers are finalized. *If a team qualifies for USAV National they must attend, and their season will extend to the end of June/early July. Nationals would be at an additional cost. Teams that win their age group in the AAU Spring Classic (or other AAU Tournament) have the opportunity to attend either AAU Nationals in Florida or the Volleyball Festival in Phoenix. Both events are in June.

Club Dues & Expenses Information

Within each portion of the club, we budget for 12 players per team, and divide all club costs for the season equally between all club members in each portion of the club. These fees include but are not limited to, practices, coaches' salaries, equipment, coaching supplies, gym rental, tournament entry fees, admin overhead. Dues plus Travel is the estimated cost for the season's *total* Club Dues for the season. **Travel policies:**

- Travel fees include transportation and lodging only for coaches for travel tournaments.
- For "Drive-to" & "Fly-to" travel tournaments, player airfare, ground transportation, and hotel are <u>not included</u>. We secure a block in team hotels for players to stay with their parents.
- For ALL travel, the club works with hotels to create a room block, so teams and parents can stay in the same hotel. Most tournaments are "stay to play" tournaments and require the teams to secure rooms from their dedicated tournament block. In some cases, the team will not be accepted into the tournament until a minimum number of rooms have been secured for each team.
- Each travel trip has a dedicated travel page with details that are relevant to each tournament, including hotel links, tournament information, etc.
- Prices below are estimates based on previous season costs. Before the start of practices, the club finalizes the
 tournament schedule, registers teams for tournaments, purchases coaches' uniforms, upgrades equipment, and pays
 other associated costs in advance of the club season. Final costs are established for the total Club Dues once our travel
 schedule and costs are finalized.

**Club registration occurs 5-7 days of tryouts with the option to pay the full season in advance or choose the installment plan. For all members, a non-refundable \$600 down payment is due when registering. There is a discount for paying the entire season at once, as well as a sibling discount. Parent must order their athlete's uniform and pay directly to the supplier by the November deadline posted at the top of the uniform fitting page.
