We look forward to having you attend the Multi District Girls 15-17 Festival at Trine University June 27 – July 2, 2026. The USA Hockey districts who are participating in this year's festival are Mid Am, Michigan, Southeast, New York and Northern Plains.

CHECK IN AND PARENT MEETING:

You will check in on Saturday June 27th between 1:00-2:30 pm in the lobby of the Thunder Ice Arena. Come to the front doors of the Ice Arena. At 3:00pm we will start the camp. Before arriving, we will conduct a parental meeting on Zoom. This will be done a few days before camp starts and a Zoom invitation will be sent to you.

Airport Transportation (Without Assistance)

For those of you who are flying in and need transportation to and from the airport, please email John Mihalik at milahikj@trine.edu, and provide all your flight information. There is a \$50 charge each way if you fly by yourself and can be picked up and dropped off at the baggage claim without assistance. This will be a separate fee paid later (not when you are registering for the camp. The airport is Detroit Metro Airport. Upon arriving, we will meet you in the baggage claim area.

Note: Each airline has an age requirement that allows someone to fly by themselves. We will only meet players in the baggage claim area. We cannot meet them at the gate at arrival or departure. Please check with your airline to make sure they can fly alone.

We would like your arrival time at the airport to be by 2:00pm on Saturday June 27. We would prefer all departures on July 2nd to be after 3:00pm.

HOUSING AND MEALS:

You will be housed in a dormitory located on Trine University's campus. You must bring your own bed linens, towels, pillow etc. We recommend a sleeping bag because the dormitory is air-conditioned. We request that you limit any electronic devices you bring. If you do have a cell phone or electronic device, they must always remain in your dorm room. We are not responsible for lost or damaged appliances or any type of electronic devices.

We will put you with a random roommate on the same team that you are assigned. If there are any medical or other valid reason that you need to room with a particular camper, please contact John Mihalik at mihalikj@trine.edu

All meals are included in the cost of the camp. If anyone has any dietary restrictions, please send John Mihalik an email so we can be better prepared to serve your dietary needs. All meals are served in the Trine University Dining hall, and they can accommodate dietary requests.

CHECK OUT:

The camp will end on Thursday July 2 no later than 11:30am. There will be four teams, and we will not know until Wednesday evening who will be playing in the first or second game.
