
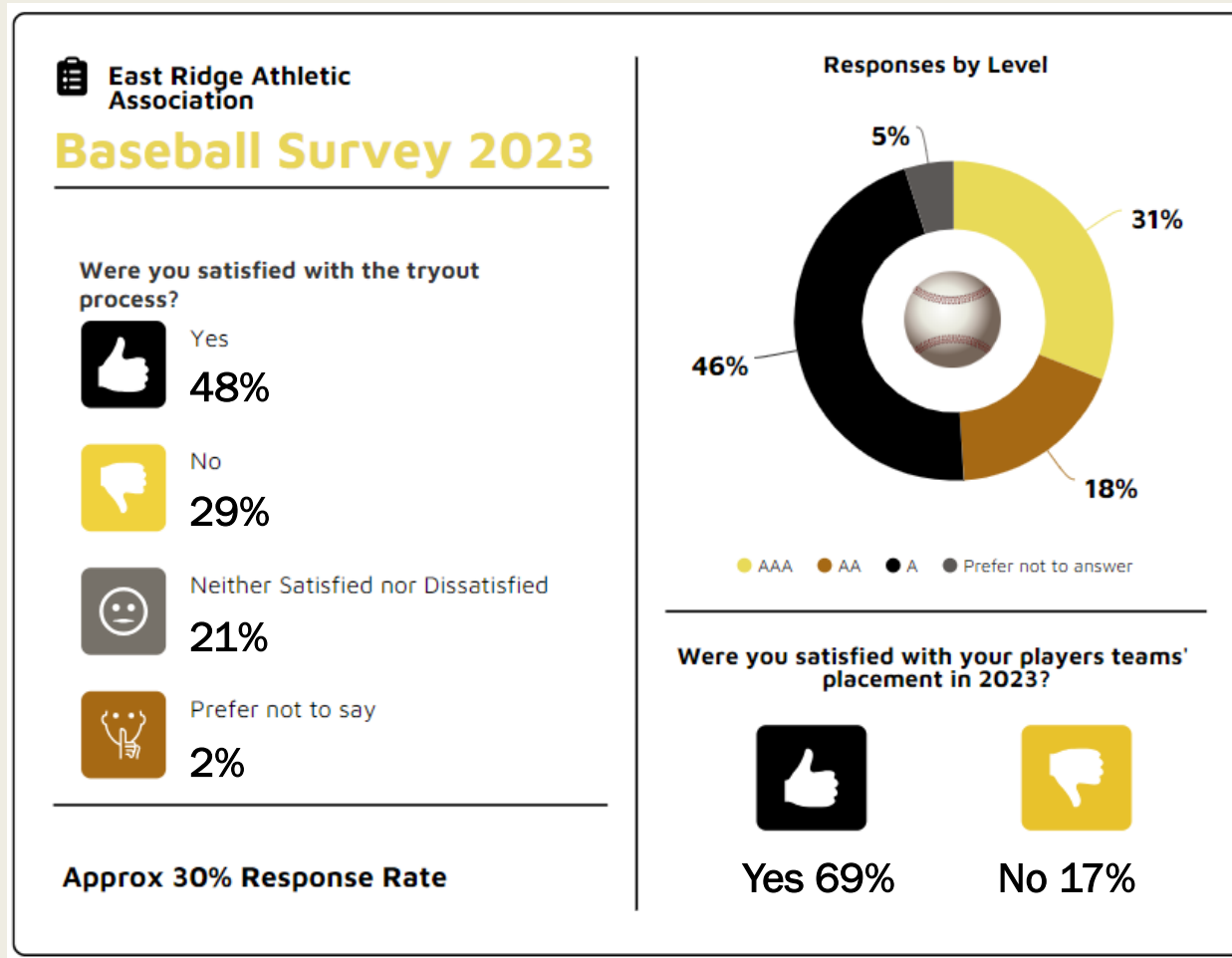


ERAA BASEBALL SURVEY PARENT RESULTS

Executive Summary



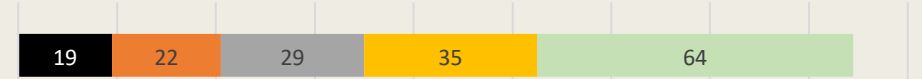
Summary Analysis findings:

- The parents and coaching staff feel that we should not do the high/low team formations and instead baseball should be evenly distributing teams on single A if we won't be offering an in-house team this upcoming season.
- 69% of parents were satisfied with their child's placement on teams, compared to 17% of those who were not (others were neither satisfied or dissatisfied).
- 76% Plan to register again for ERAA baseball next year.
- 46% of respondents were single A families.

Roughly 170 survey results were received. Not all questions were answered by all parties, some questions requested multiple selections.

I trust the coaches at my child's current level more than the independent evaluator to properly assess a player and put them on the correct team.



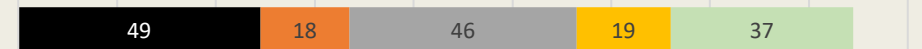
Coaches should be a part of the tryout process.



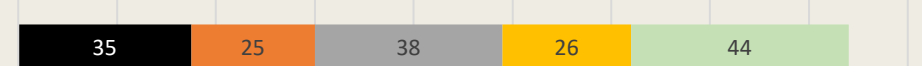
I trust the evaluators more than I trust the current ERAA Baseball coaches to properly place my child on the right team.



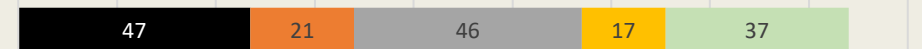
Players on high/low teams should have different multipliers.



Multipliers ensure that players are placed on the right team for their abilities.



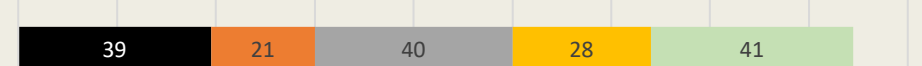
Multipliers should not be used in the ACR.

I think that the use of multipliers are a good way to determine a player's ability?



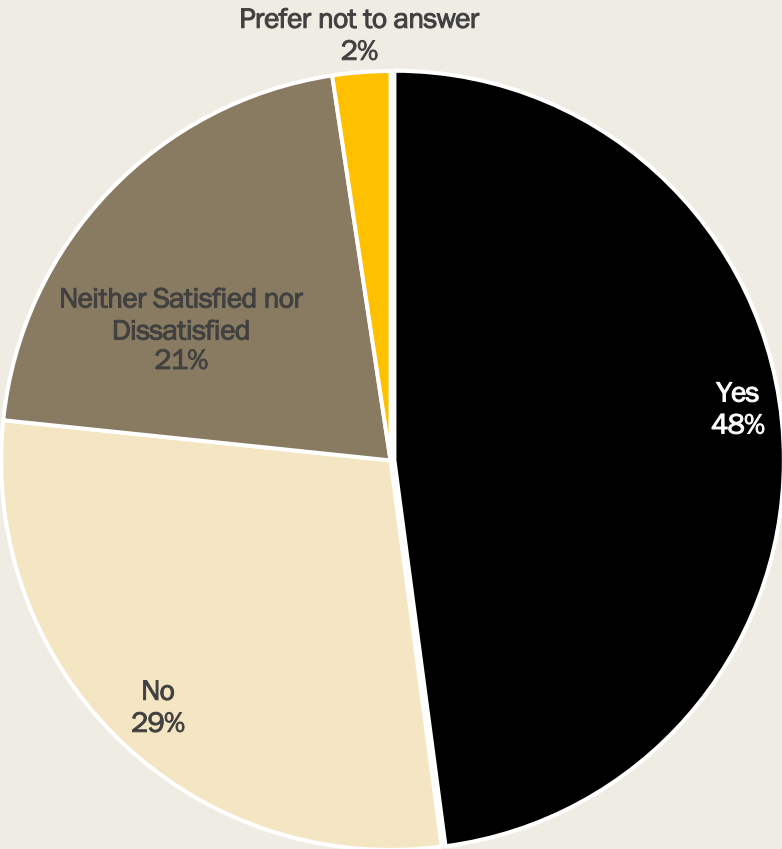
I was aware of the use of multipliers in a player's evaluation prior to this season?

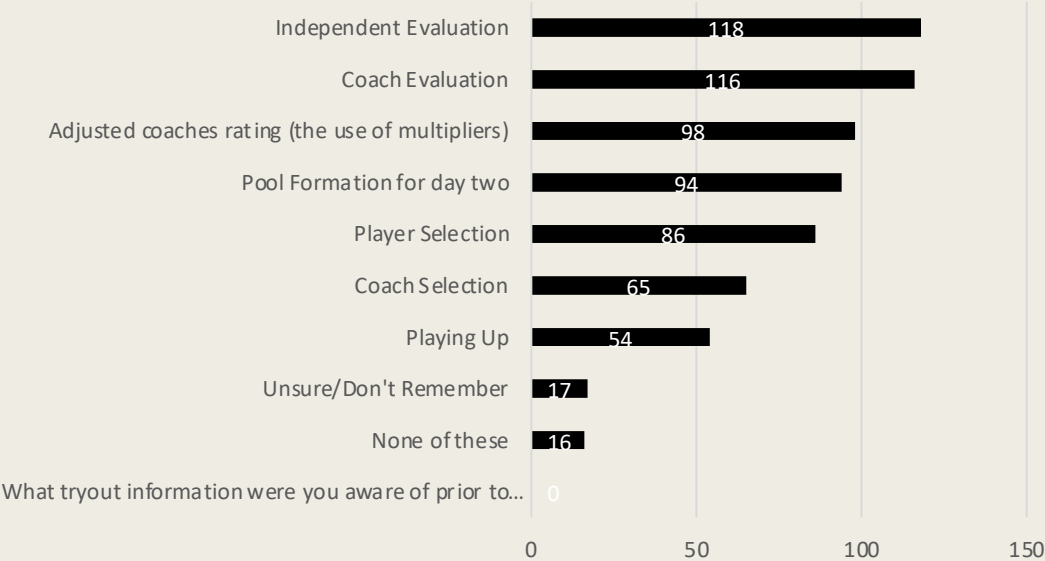

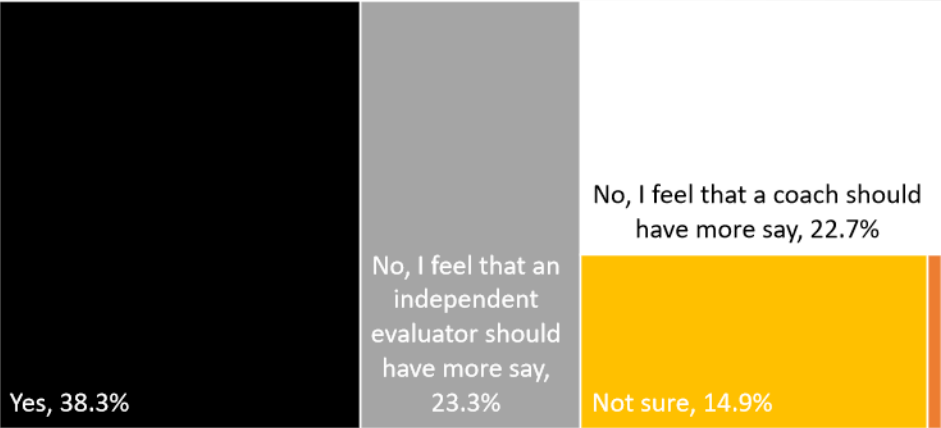


Were you satisfied with the tryout process?

What tryout information were you aware of prior to your registration for the 2023 season?



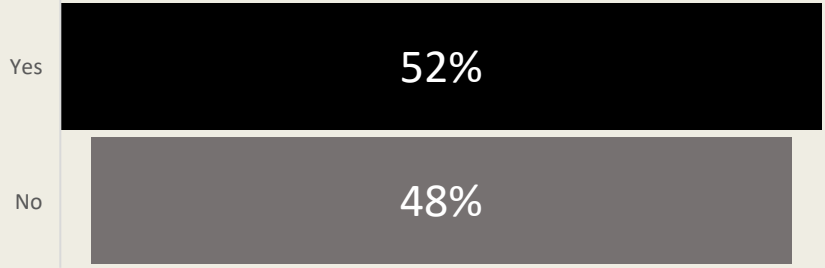
Do you feel that ERAA Baseball strikes the right balance between coach and independent evaluation?



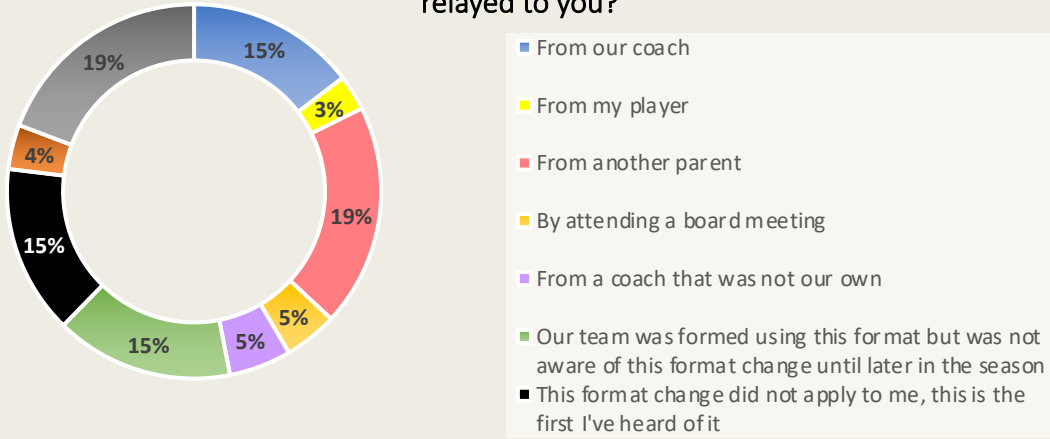

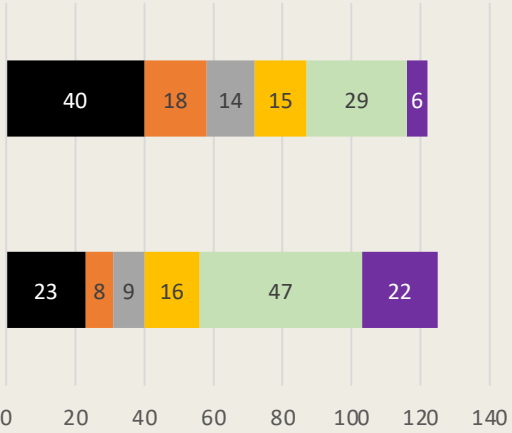
Were you aware of the 2023 high/low format change for age groups with multiple teams at the A level?



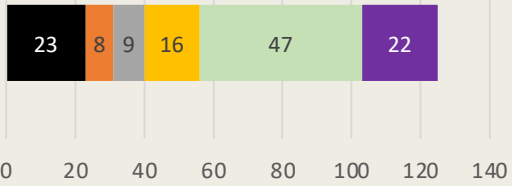
If you were aware of the format, how was this information initially relayed to you?



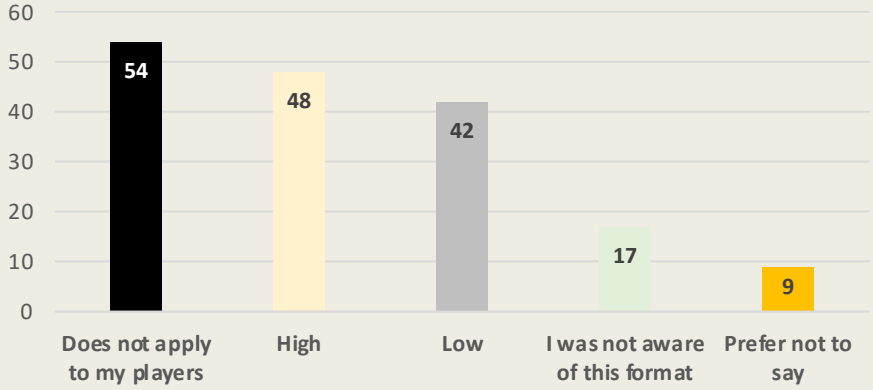
When there are multiple teams at the same level (AAA, AA, or A) ERAA Baseball should use the high/low format to make teams of players of similar ability to make the games fun and fair.



My player was aware that there was a high/low format.



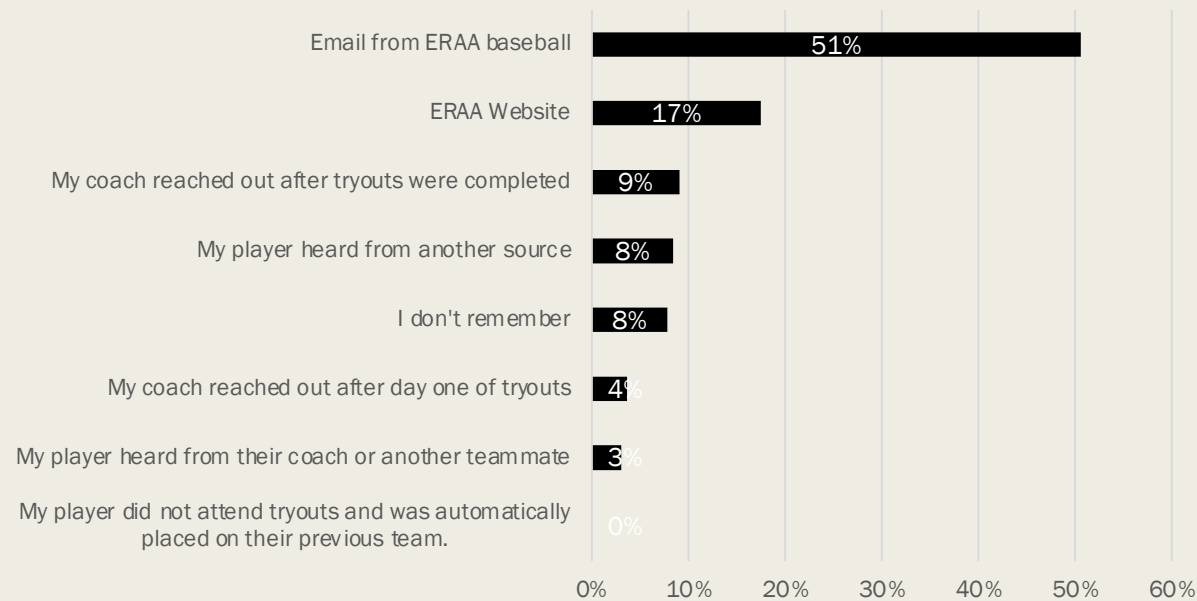

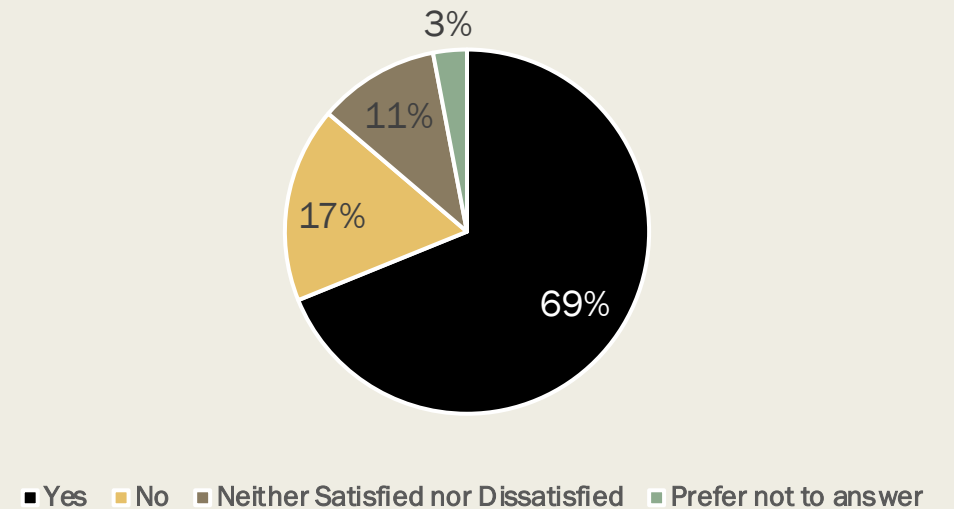

How were you made aware of placement?

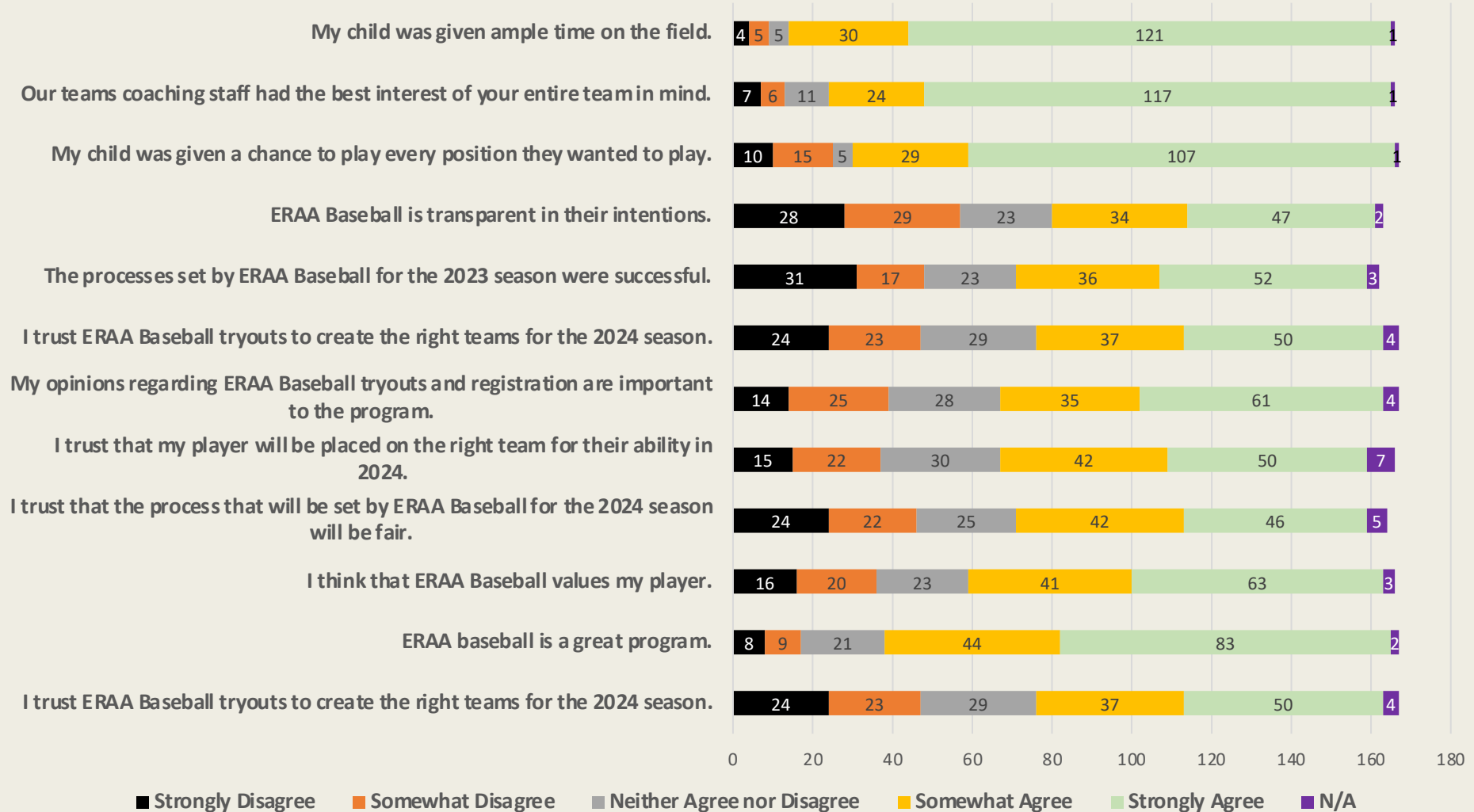


Were you satisfied with your players teams placement in 2023?



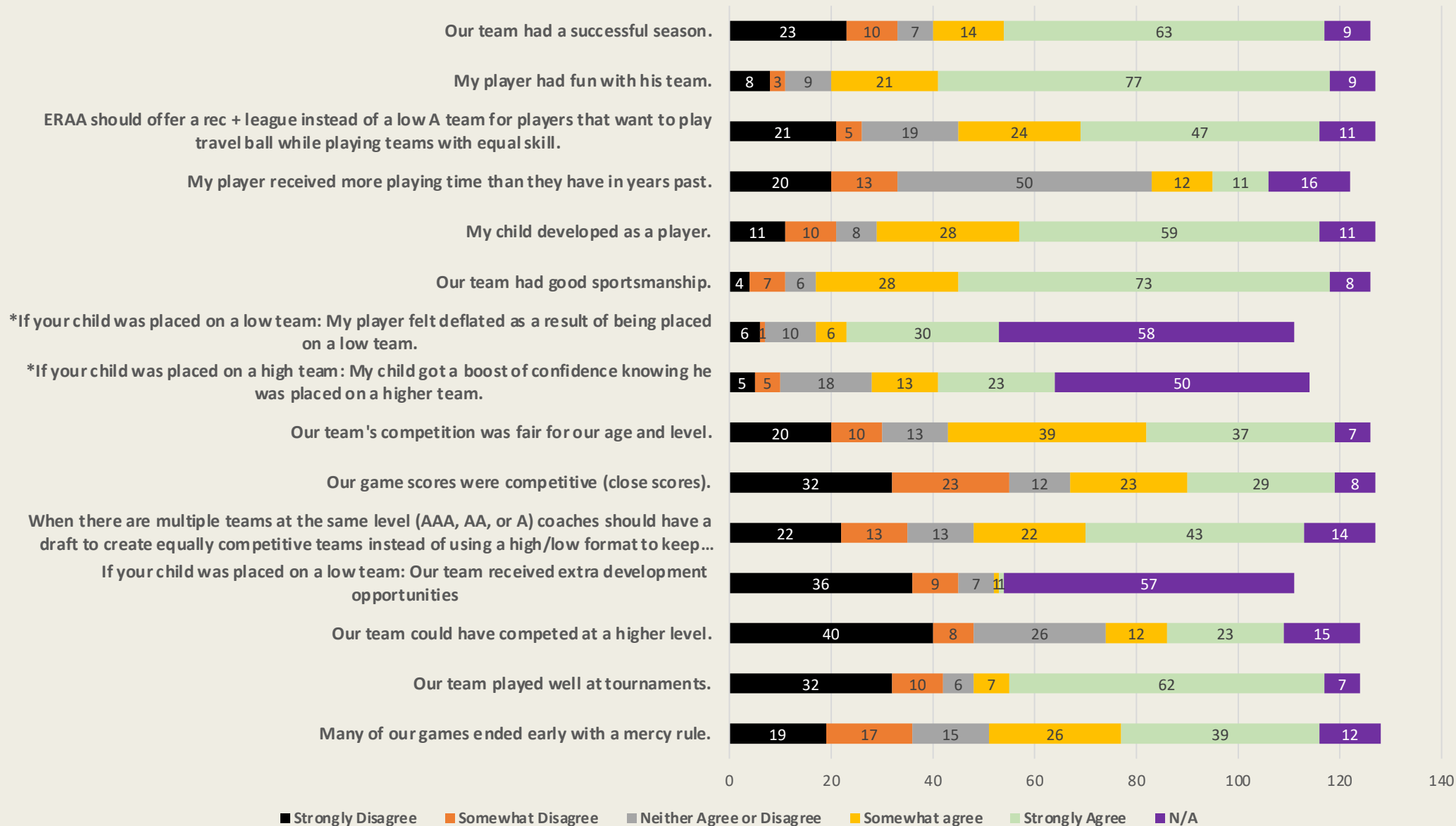

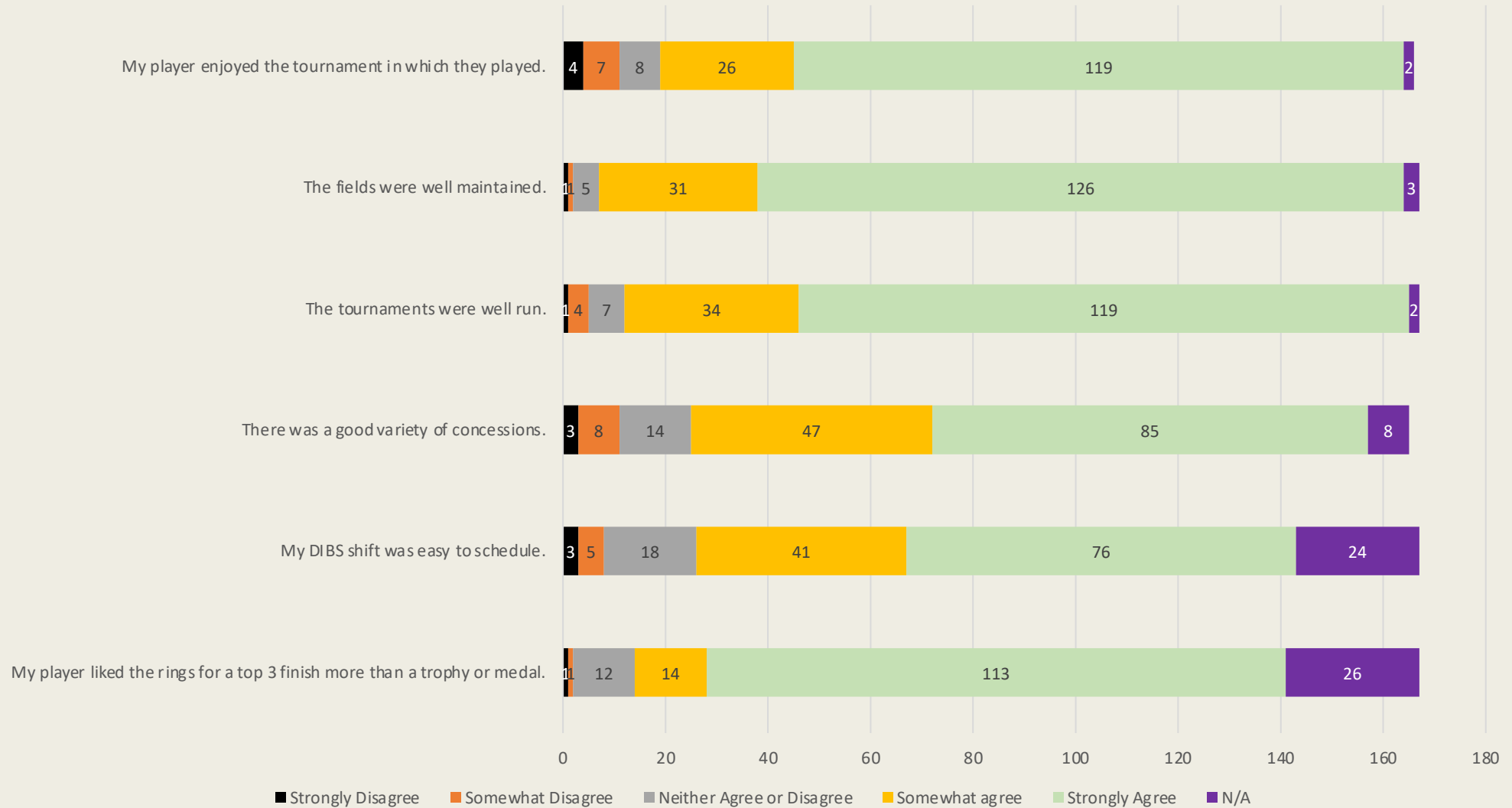

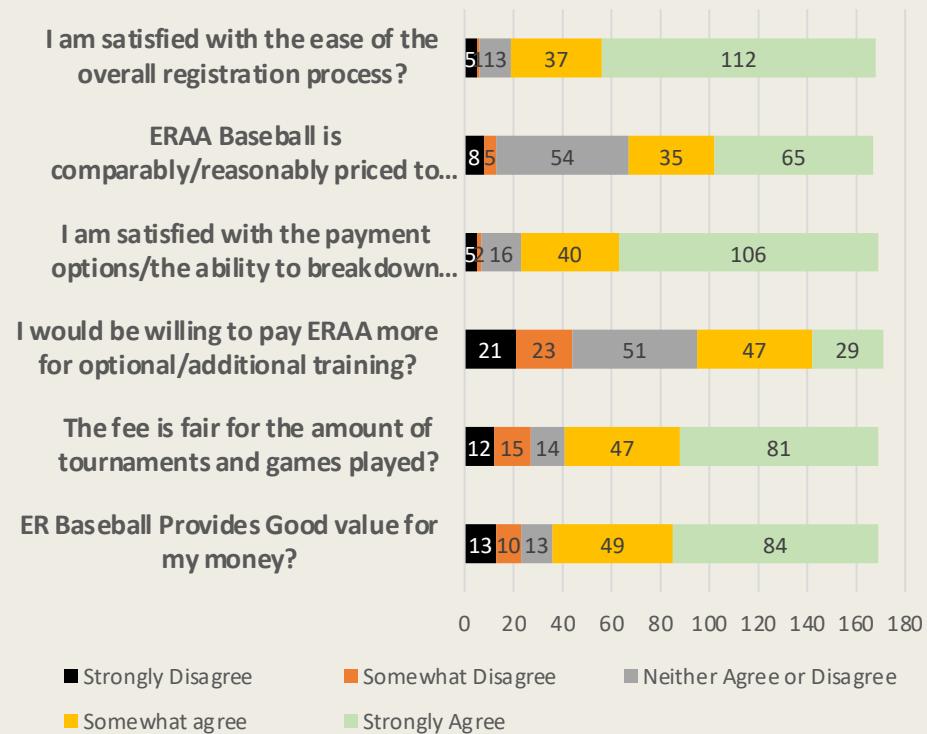

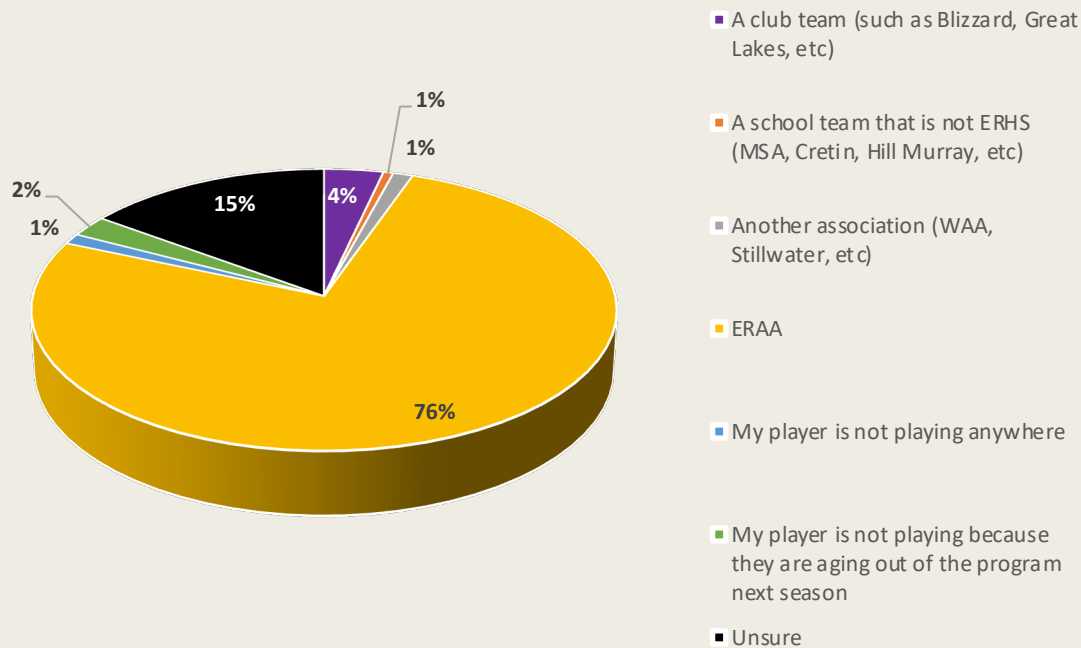

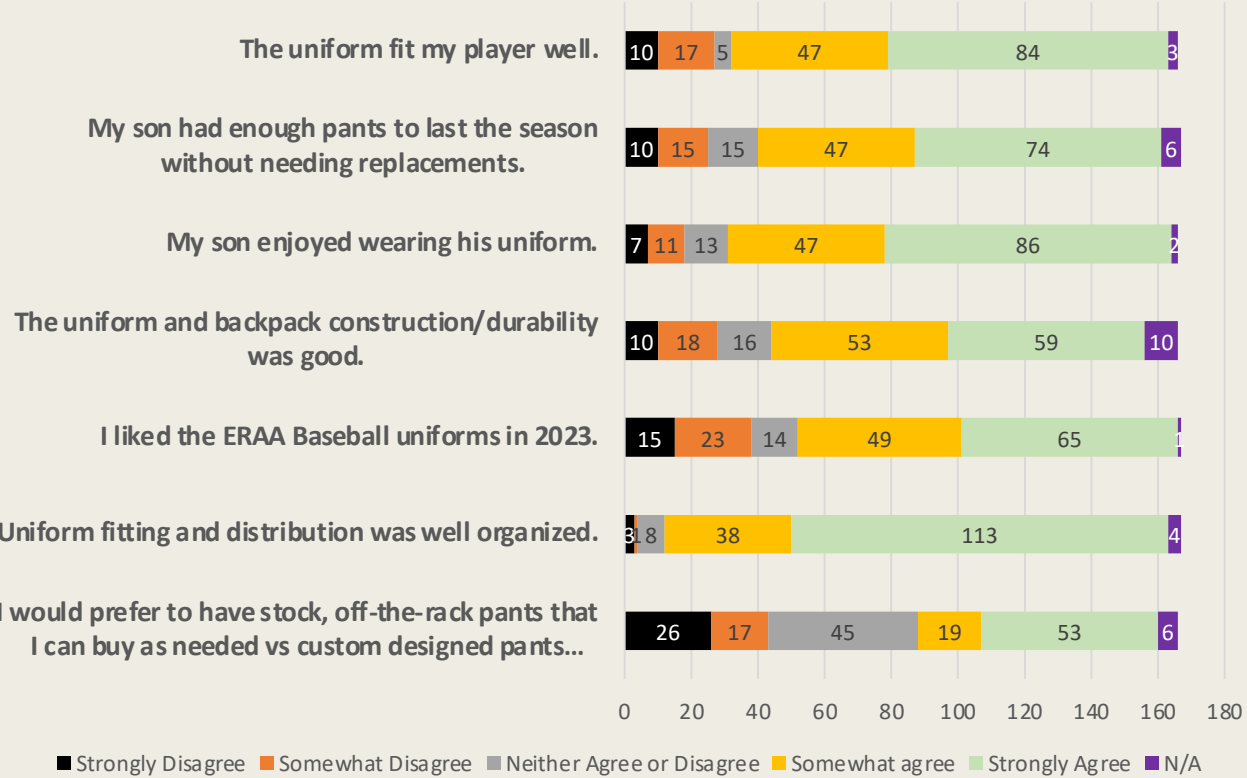


Where does your player plan to register to play baseball in 2024?

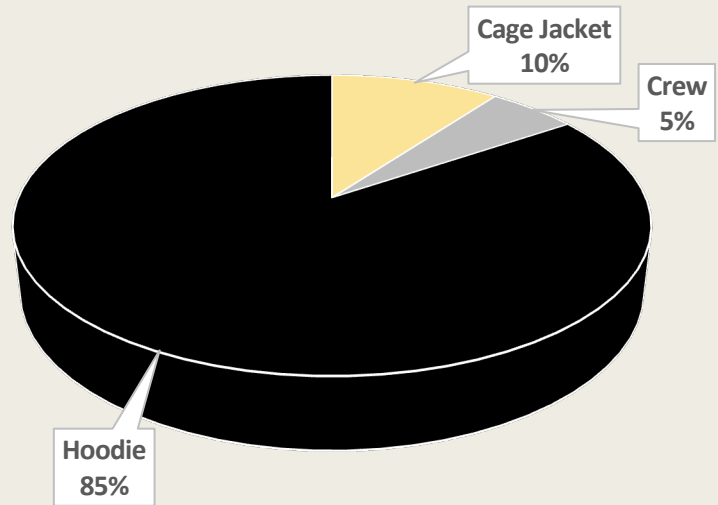

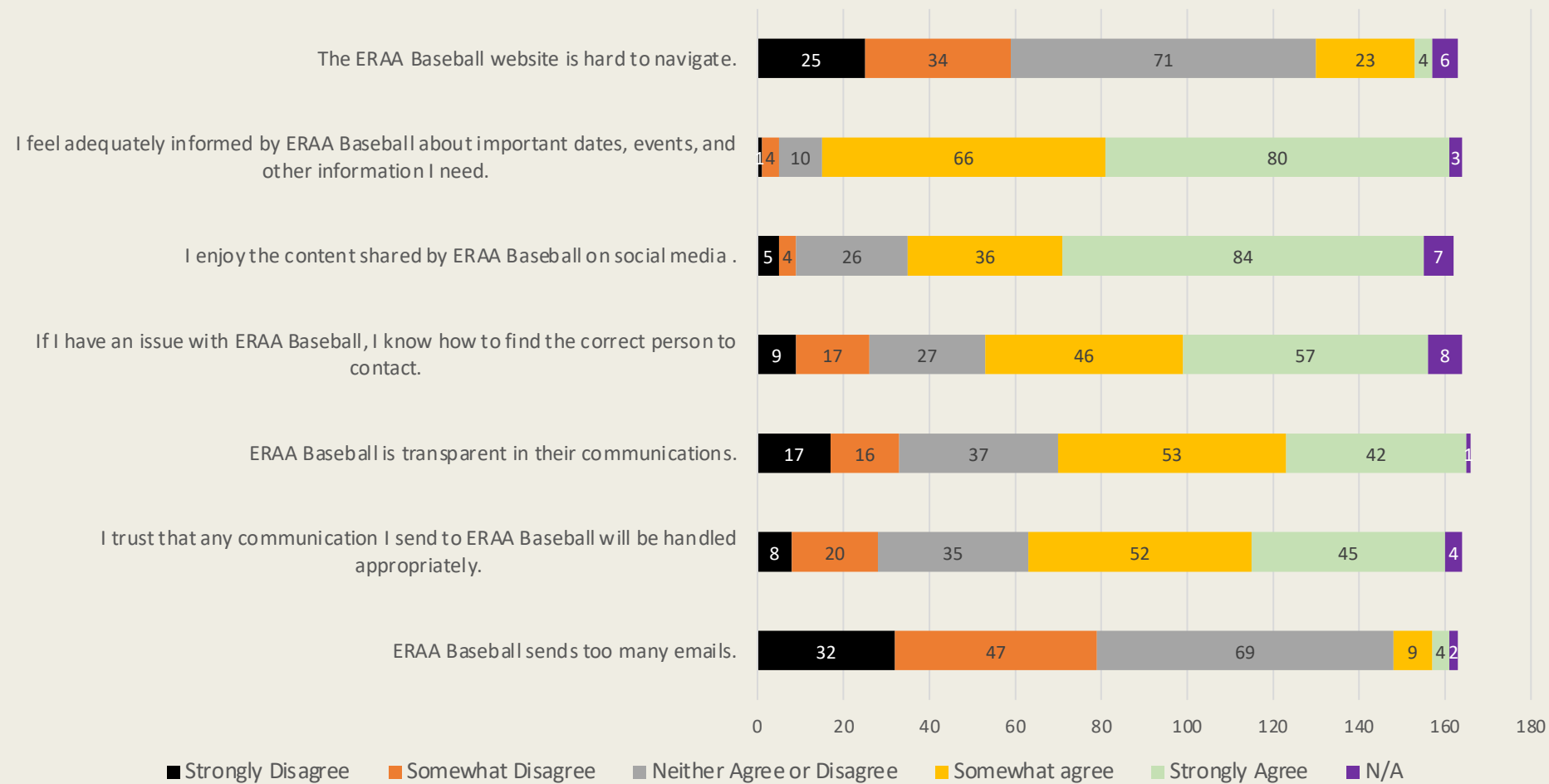


Which would your son prefer next season?
