and schools became professor, but always knew his real desire was to give himself entirely to a life of prayer. Peter eventually quit teaching and became hermit, а completely devoted to prayer. wrote many letters. biographies and sermons which are still studied to this day, and

was named a Doctor of the Church. Saint Peter Damian challenges us to look at our own prayer lives. Is our prayer leading us into a deeper discipleship of Christ?
