PLAYER/PARENT CONTRACT

I agree to become a member of the Illinois Futbol Club (Illinois FC), and understand that such membership entails the following expectations:

- All required fees will be paid when they are due. Failure to do so will result in the removal of the player’s card and the player will be unable to play until dues are paid. Player fees are non-refundable except in case of injury or a player moving out of town.
- Players are expected to attend all games and trainings. Illinois FC understands that there may be occasional sessions that must be missed, however, players must make every effort to attend all sessions.
- Players will be on time to all sessions with appropriate attire, soccer ball, and water.
- Player/parents will notify the coach, preferably at least 24 hours in advance, if the player will miss training. Player/parents will notify the coach, preferably at least 2 weeks in advance, if the player will miss a game or tournament (to allow time to secure guest players). Failure to do so on a consistent basis could result in suspension from the team.
- Each family will volunteer a total of up to 9 hours of service during the two Illinois FC tournaments (no more than 6 hours in a single tournament). U15-U19 Girls/Boys are only required to volunteer up to 6 hours at the tournament held during the season in which they play. U9-U15 (8th Grade) Girls/Boys must volunteer for both the Fall Cup and Spring Invite tournaments.
- Player/parents will be available and responsive to communication from the Coach, Parent Rep, Director of Coaching, and Club.
- Players will do the best they can each day, remembering that everyone has talents and weaknesses.
- Players will practice on their own, come prepared to learn, and to give coaches and trainers their complete attention.
- Players/parents pledge to “Honor the Game.” Players/parents understand the importance of setting a good example for the team and the club. No matter what others may do, players and parents will show respect for all involved in the game and display respect for the rules, officials, opponents, officials, teammates, and self. Players/parents understand that officials make mistakes. If the official makes a “bad” call against my team, players/parents will Honor the Game and be silent!
- Players/parents will actively represent Illinois FC in a positive manner both on and off the field.
- Players/parents will not bully or treat others with disrespect.
- Players/parents will bring any questions or concerns to the attention of the coach or the Director of Coaching. If a player or parent has a concern or complaint after a game or training, he/she will abide by the 24 hour cooling off period before contacting the coach or Director of Coaching. This does not apply to situations that may be immediate safety concerns, these should be brought to coach/DOC attention immediately.

By signing this contract, I agree to become a member of Illinois Futbol Club, and I agree to do everything in my power to assist my player to meet the above expectations. **Failure to meet the above expectations may result in suspension or removal from the team. If a player is suspended or removed from a team due to violating this contract, all fees are non- refundable.**
