



South Dakota USA Wrestling Triple Crown Weekend

Date: Friday-Saturday May 3-4, 2019

Location: Madison High School- Madison, SD

Weigh-Ins & Registration: *Pre-Registration and payment is MANDATORY. Deadline 5/1/19. <https://tinyurl.com/y6ttk8d8>*

Folkstyle: *Friday May 3, 2019 3:30 PM – 4:30 PM (Weigh-in Counts for all styles)*

Greco-Freestyle Only: *Friday May 3, 2019 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM or Saturday May 4, 2019 7:30 AM-8:00 AM*

Medical Check: We will be conducting skin checks during weigh ins.

Folkstyle Friday- *Registrations will be capped at 300 wrestlers, so register early!*

Doors Open To Public/Spectators: 4:30 PM Wrestling Starts: 5:30 PM

We will wrestle straight through until completion of all folkstyle matches Friday night.

Olympic Style Saturday- *No limits will be placed on registration.*

Doors Open to Public/Spectators: 8:00 AM Wrestling Starts: 9:30 AM

There will be a 45 minute break between styles to reset Trackwrestling and prepare for the second style. Greco will be first, freestyle will be second.

Official/Volunteers: Officials and volunteers are needed to help any event run smoothly. Please email the event organizers if you would like to volunteer. Adult volunteers must have at least a USAW Volunteer Membership to verify background check and Safesport certification. Officials and volunteers will be treated to a hospitality room, a social Saturday after the conclusion of the event, and an event/volunteer t-shirt. Mat Officials will be paid \$50 for folkstyle, and \$75 per Olympic Style. There will be an Olympic Style officials clinic Friday night after the folkstyle tourney.

Age Divisions & Weights: We will be using the official USAW Age/Weight Divisions and period times as found at <http://content.themat.com/forms/Weights.pdf> (see last page of this information packet) up through USA Junior for both boys and girls. There will be a GIRLS ONLY DIVISION for each style! HEADGEAR IS REQUIRED FOR ALL DIVISIONS UP THROUGH 14-U

Awards: Medals for 1st through 4th in each style.

SDUSAW Triple Crown to any SD resident that wins all 3 styles at this tournament. ***Out of state wrestlers are not eligible for Triple Crown.***

Junior and 16U wrestlers that have won a State title in the current year are exempt from having to wrestle in the Folkstyle segment. If they choose to wrestle and lose, but win the other two styles, they would still earn the Triple Crown.

Entry Fee/Admission:

- Boys: \$15 per style; \$35 for all three styles; \$25 if doing both GR and Freestyle
- Girls: \$5 per style (No reductions)
- **OUT OF STATE COMPETITORS WELCOME**
 - ***\$15 Out-Of-State Competitor Entry fee at the door regardless of how many styles entered. This will be IN ADDITION to the online or walk-in entry fee.***
- This is a USAW Sanctioned event. All athletes, coaches, volunteers, and officials must have proper USAW Membership from www.usawmembership.com
 - Athletes competing in FOLKSTYLE ONLY may compete with the “Limited Folkstyle” membership option; “Full Membership” or higher is required for Olympic Styles
- Spectator Admission: Adults \$5 (All-Session Pass); kids, seniors, and military FREE
- Coaching: Free admission with USAW Leader Membership
 - Free Coaching band for all NCEP Certified Coach, and NCEP certification is required to receive coaching credentials to be allowed in the corner.

Concessions: Concessions will be available; WRESTLERS will be allowed ONE small personal cooler for healthy snacks and/or beverages.
