LOSTOCK, CHORLEY NEW ROAD, VICTORIA ROAD/BEAUMONT ROAD (A58),  
BOLTON TOWN CENTRE, MIDDLEBROOK RETAIL PARK

We would like to thank the local community, councils and athletes for supporting this event over the last years and are delighted to bring IRONMAN 70.3 Bolton back on Sunday 30th June 2024.

**Temporary road closures will be in place on IRONMAN race day** to ensure the safety of athletes and the public.

These legal road closures are implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, and apply to all motorized vehicles, cycles and equestrian traffic that are not involved in the event.

- Please avoid parking on the bike course for safety reasons.
- Pedestrians **CAN** cross the course at any time when safe to do so.

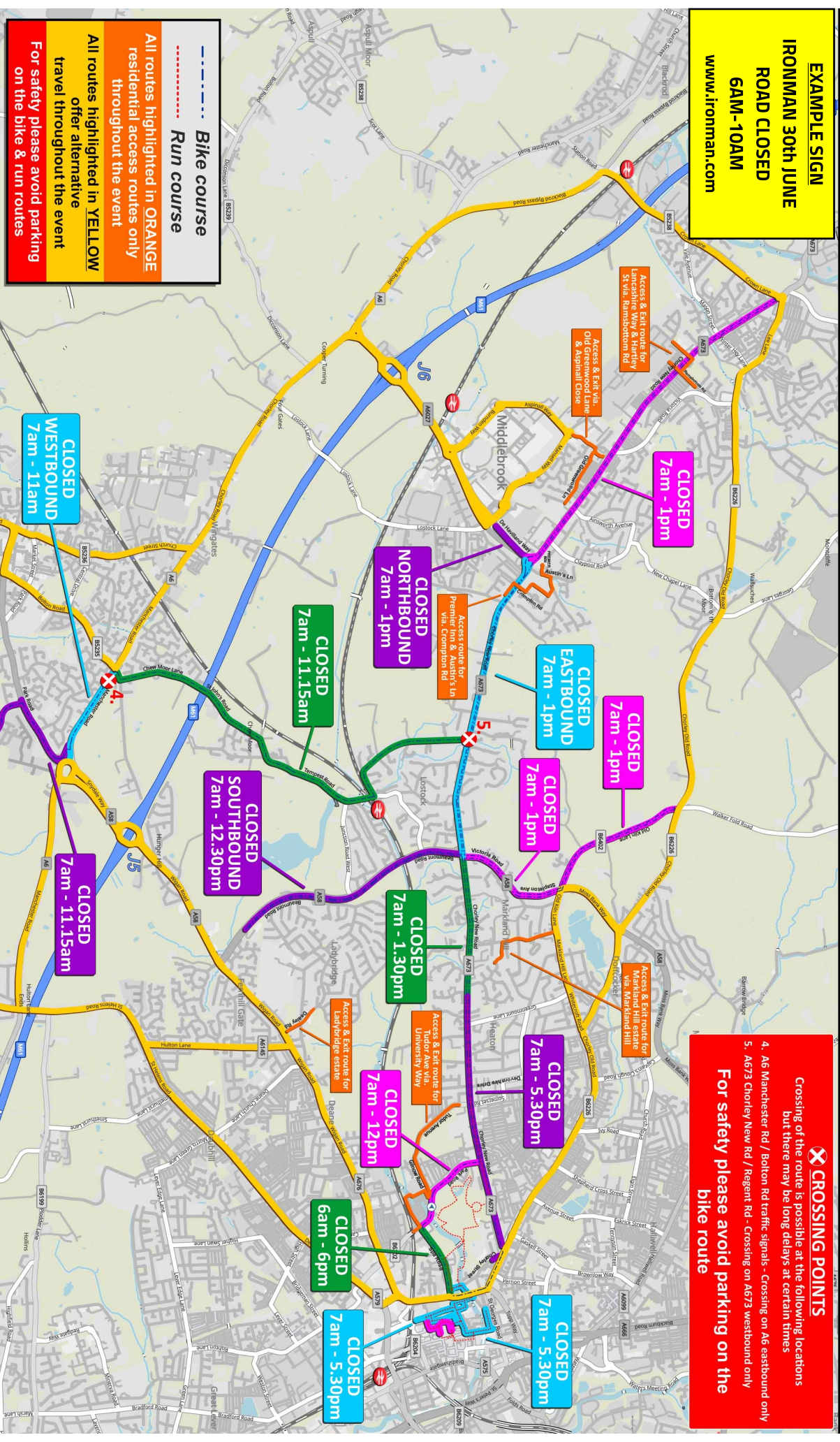
AREA	CLOSURES	DETAILS
CHORLEY NEW ROAD, VICTORIA RD (A58), OLD KILN LANE, BEAUMONT RD	VARIOUS CLOSURES FROM 07:00 - 17:30	<p>The bikes will turn left from Regent Rd onto CNR and will continue past The Beehive roundabout towards Horwich. The bikes will U-Turn before The Crown Pub and continue back towards Bolton.</p> <p><b>ACCESS ADVICE</b> - CNR from Beaumont Rd (A58) - The Beehive Roundabout will be closed EASTBOUND ONLY from 07:00-13:00. There will be access Westbound throughout the day. Please see Beehive Premier Inn access on the map overleaf. De Havilliand Way will be closed NORTHBOUND ONLY from 07:00 - 13:00. CNR from The Beehive Roundabout to The Crown Pub will be FULLY CLOSED from 07:00-13:00.</p> <p><b>Crossing Point 5</b> - As seen overleaf. Crossing on A673 at Regent Rd junction WESTBOUND ONLY.</p> <p>Athletes will turn left on Victoria Road (A58) and left onto Old Kiln Lane for an out and back section. They will U-turn before the Chorley Old Road Junction and return to CNR using the route above in reverse. They will then turn left on CNR back towards Bolton.</p> <p><b>ACCESS ADVICE</b> - Victoria Rd (A58) and Old Kiln Lane will be FULLY CLOSED from 07:00-13:00. Markland Hill Estate exit and entry access via removed bollards on Whitland Avenue.</p> <p>Once back on CNR athletes will continue all the way to St George's Rd where they will turn right and right again onto Marsden Street (B6205). They will then turn right onto Spa Rd past Queen's Park and right onto Mayor Street/Park Road before returning onto CNR Westbound.</p> <p><b>ACCESS ADVICE</b> - Bikes will take one lane of St George's Rd and Marsden Rd to allow free flowing traffic throughout the day.</p> <p>Athletes will continue West on CNR towards Horwich and will turn left onto Beaumont Rd (A58) southbound for another out and back section. The bikes will U-turn by the old Britannia Hotel and will return onto CNR, Athletes will complete the above lap twice before finishing in Queen's Park, Bolton.</p> <p><b>ACCESS ADVICE</b> - CNR from Beaumont Rd (A58) to Waterslea Drive will be FULLY CLOSED from 07:00-13:30. CNR from Waterslea Drive to St George's Rd (B6226) will be FULLY CLOSED 07:00-17:30 due to the road being used by both bike and run courses. Ladybridge Estate access in and out is available via Wigan Rd/ Dealey Rd all day.</p> <p>If access to the southside of CNR is required it is advised to park on a side street on the north of the road and</p>
MIDDLEBROOK RETAIL PARK	OPEN AS NORMAL	<p>Middlebrook Retail Park is open as normal on race day and throughout race week.</p> <p><b>ACCESS ADVICE:</b> If accessing Middlebrook from Bolton it is advised (in motorway approved vehicles only) to use the A676 / A58 South to the M61 Junction 5. Exit the M61 at Junction 6 and north on the A6027.</p>
LOSTOCK	07:00 – 11:15	<p>The bike course will follow Atherleigh Way (A579) to the Chequerbent roundabout and continue as normal through Chewmoor and Lostock using the railway bridge onto Regent Rd before joining Chorley New Road travelling Westbound and making a U-turn by The Crown Pub roundabout before returning to Bolton.</p> <p><b>ACCESS ADVICE</b>- Chew Moor Ln, St John's Rd, Tempest Rd, Regent Rd will be closed between 07:00-11:15.</p>
BOLTON TOWN CENTRE	28th June - 30th June	<p>There will be closures in Bolton Town Centre from Friday 28th June until 6pm Sunday 30th June. This is due to the event site being built and dismantled along with the weekend events - Friday Night Run, Saturday IRONKIDS and Sunday IRONMAN 70.3 Bolton.</p>
