Who is invited and how does a player join the Rink Rat Club?

- NM Ice Wolves, NM Mustangs and NM Blade Runners players registered this season
- Memberships are available this season on an introductory basis starting Monday, December 17 and ending on January 31st for \$99 at the front desk at Outpost

What exactly is the Rink Rat Club?

- An exclusive club for young hockey and sled hockey players
- Unlimited public skating at any Outpost Ice Arenas™ public skating and/or CoolLoop® sessions
 - *Note that Outpost Ice Arenas will be closed from April 1-May 17, 2018*
- 25% Discount for Outpost Stick & Puck sessions
 - Subject to normal restrictions on number of participants
- Exclusive membership card which must be presented at the front desk in order to receive benefits
- Specials and Discounts at the Pro Shop and Snack bar from time to time

What are rules of the Rink Rat Club?

- Good behavior is expected at all times on and off the ice
- Safe behavior is expected at all times on and off the ice
- All skaters must be courteous and respectful of all other skaters
- All skaters must always be especially respectful and cautious of less experienced skaters
 - Offering help to less experienced skaters is encouraged
- All Outpost Ice Arenas rules must be followed
- Tag and other safe games are allowed during public skating sessions
 - If Outpost staff deems the ice too crowded based on the number and/or mix of skaters on the ice, they will let skaters know that games and tag are to be suspended for that session
- Any skaters or Rink Rat Club members that disobey Outpost Staff will be asked to leave the ice
- Outpost Staff reserves the right to call parents to report any serious or continuing behavior problems and to suspend or revoke membership privileges to any individual without refund
