2020-21 Timberwolves Hockey Club COVID-19 Policies

- As the legal guardian/parent of the registered member agree to assume the risks of participating with the Timberwolves Hockey Club, waive any and all claims, damages, liabilities and loses arising out of or related to the premises and or in participating in activities while registered with the Timberwolves Hockey Club.
- I understand that among such risks are the unforeseeable risks related to the current COVID-19 virus. I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 which I may expose myself, the registered participant and or any member of our family which may lead to contracting the illness.
- As legal guardian/parent of the registered member agree to freely and voluntarily participate with the Timberwolves Hockey Club knowing the risks related to COVID-19 and understand this waiver covers any claims based on COVID-19 infection or exposure occurring, before, during or after scheduled events in participation with the Timberwolves Hockey Club.
- In the event you, your player or someone you live with tests positive for COVID-19, you must notify the club and your head coach.
- If a player or coach tests positive for COVID-19, that individual must quarantine themselves from all Timberwolves Hockey Club related events in compliance with the guidelines set forth by the CDC Guidelines. Player or coach may return when they have received a negative test and a letter of release from a physician indicating they are cleared to return to sports.
- If a family member of a player or coach who resides in the same home as the registered player or coach tests positive for COVID-19, that player or coach must be quarantine until the incubation period has passed and they can provide a negative test.
- In the event a player or coach test positive, all team members will be notified. Team members shall follow the advice of their personal health care provider to determine quarantine requirements regarding their exposure. Depending on level of exposure you may be required to quarantine and be tested for COVID-19 before returning to play.

- Everyone entering the Triphahn center and or any other facility as it relates to participation with the Timberwolves Hockey Club must wear a mask. Players MUST wear masks in the locker room before and after practices, games, any team activities until player is ready to take to the ice.
- Players are encouraged to dress in as much equipment as possible prior to entering the rink to limit time in the locker rooms. Players are required to maintain safe distances while using the locker rooms with other players present.
- No large gatherings are allowed within the Triphahn center before, during or after any team practices, games or team functions.
- All players shall wash their hands often, refrain from sharing any equipment and water bottles.

Failure to follow any of the guidelines set in place by the Timberwolves Hockey Club will result in the inability to participate in team activities and events. Our ability to safely remain on the ice will be directly related to the efforts put forth to ensure a safe environment for our members.

Amendments

Amendment #1

This addendum goes into affect as of September 23rd, 2020

Any coach and/or player that has been directly exposed with any person carrying COVID-19 they must quarantine and be tested. That player and/or coach can only return to play if they have either quarantined for a minimum of 14 days or the can provide a negative test for COVID-19.

Amendment #2

This addendum goes into affect as of November 5th, 2020

Any coach/player that is confirmed with COVID-19 may not return until: they have had no fever for 24 hours (without medicine) and other sypmtoms have improved. And at least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeareed

Amendment #3

This addendum goes into affect as of November 5th, 2020

Any coach/player that has been exposed to someone who has been COVID-19 may not return until: at least 14 days have passed since their first day of exposure. If the exposed coach/player exposure results in a positive COVID-19 diagnosis they must follow the guildelines above to return after diagnosis.
