



# MOYSC COVID-19 GUIDELINES, PROCEDURES AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Updated 7-11-2021

## RISK OF EXPOSURE

While the MOYSC endeavors to reduce the risks, individuals who enter on MOYSC premises or participate in MOYSC sponsored activities may be exposed to infectious bacteria, viruses, or other pathogens, including MRSA, influenza, and the COVID-19 virus.

Parents should monitor the health of their children and not send them to participate in sporting activities if they exhibit any symptom of COVID-19. They should seek COVID-19 testing promptly and report results to the program given the implications for other children, families, and staff.

## IN GAME RULE CHANGES

- Please encourage senior citizens and others with health issues to social distance or wear a mask.
- Players and coaches should wash their hands after each game.
- No team water will be allowed. All individual player bottles must be marked with their name.
- Teams are asked to keep score on their own score book, GameChanger™ or another electronic device.
- Encourage parents to supply their players with antibacterial wipes and hand sanitizer for disinfecting shared playing equipment and cleaning hands between innings/quarters/periods
- If a player or coach contracts the virus during the season, the player/coach will quarantine for 10 days.

## COMPLEX CLEANING

- Teams must clean their dugout of all trash and other items after each game or practice.
- Complex will provide hand sanitation throughout the complex.

## RESTROOMS

- Restrooms will be cleaned twice a week by a third-party cleaning company.
- Parents should accompany all children to the restrooms.
- Please wash hands before and after using the restrooms.
- Please avoid touching your face while in the restroom and anytime at the complex due to personal safety.

## CONCESSION STAND

- Concession Stand may be open during the season
