Tim Whitford coached varsity softball for 25 years at Winneconne High School. He coached in 574 games with a record of 365-209. Out of the 25 seasons, he only had 4 losing seasons. His teams won 7 Conference Championships, 5 Regional Championships and was Sectional Runner-Up to 2010 State Champions Lux-Casco. He coached 50 1st team All-Conference Players, 6 All Conference Players of the Year and 7 All District/All State Players. Ten Winneconne players played in the WFSCA All Star Game. Tim and his coaching staff, (Rob Berndt, Mike Krueger, Ray Lee and Lee Peerenboom) coached in the All-Star Game in 2010 and 2017.
