Pastor's Message

This Sunday, St. Peter's Church and School, celebrates with the Universal Church, its patron's feast day! This feast seldom falls on a Sunday. Our first St. Peter's Church was erected in 1878 and the present one was completed around 1918.

The first church in the area was St. Joseph's in Pfeffer Valley in 1858. The School Sisters of Notre Dame ... built a school, orphanage, and the "Convent Church" (Blessed Sacrament) in 1867.

The altar in our St. Joseph Hall (off the elevator) is from the earlier St. Joseph's Church. Recognizing our roots and dedication to St. Joseph, the diocese has given us, at our request, a statue of St. Joseph, which will be blest on our Feast Day of St. Peter and will be stationed in the Gathering Area under the pictures of Pope Leo XIV and Bishop Barron. Fred Ross is building the stand for it out of our old wood pews.

ST. PETER'S GOOD NEWS – Our Church Bells. The controls and equipment that run our church bells and the music it plays were installed in 1978. Some of you will remember at one time we had the ability to play all three bells and special music for different occasions. Over time the contacts in the controls for the music broke down and we had to discontinue some of the sequences. The company that we purchased the controls from in Pennsylvania is still in business, but they no longer make replacement parts. Recently Danny Von Arx brought it to our attention that the bells no longer worked properly. We were able to locate replacement parts made in Mexico on eBay. Special thanks to Jonah Ross who disassembled the old controls and reinstalled the new ones. All three bells and all music sequences are now working again as they had in 1978! Our ushers will begin playing this before mass in the coming weeks. Thanks again Danny and Jonah!
