

Jean Bowar Recreational Scholarship

By filling out this application, you will be considered for the Jean Bowar Recreational Scholarship through the Dakota Alliance Soccer Cub (DASC). This application is required for the scholarships awarded for the 2023-2024 Academic Year. Two scholarship awards will be given out for the 2023-2024 Academic Year: one (1), \$1,000 Scholarship for a boy and one (1), \$1,000 Scholarship for a girl.

Eligibility Requirements

In order to apply for the Jean Bowar Recreational Scholarship, you must:

- 1) be a current or past player with the DASC Recreational Program or a current Sioux Falls high school soccer team player
- 2) be a graduating senior with plans to continue your education (trade or certificate program, two-year college/technical school or 4-year college or university)
- 3) have a Cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Immediate Relatives of Jean Bowar and/or of past/present full-time DASC employees are not eligible for this scholarship. There is not a requirement to demonstrate that there is a financial need by the applicant. There is no requirement for the applicant to play soccer post high school to be considered for this scholarship.

Application Required Documents

- 2) Short Essay Questions and Answers (page 3)
- 3) One Letter of Recommendation
 - a. This can be from a teacher, coach, employer or other professional/mentor who can speak to your character.

 Letters should not be written by family members or DASC Scholarship Committee Members. These letters need to be emailed/mailed directly from the writer. Applicants may not send in the letter.
