

MISSOURI HOCKEY, INC.
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING TO CONSIDER APPEALS
June 17, 2020

MEMBERS PRESENT: Culiberk, Hellwig, Sivcovich, Smith, Woolf, Busenhart, Mouser, Greenbury, Durso, Ney, Bumb, Boyd and Baker

This special meeting was called to order by Pat Culiberk at 7:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering appeals regarding the new YD Central States rules as they effect prior OTT transfers. Initaly there were 5 appeals, however the appeals of Gissy and Lopiccolo were dropped since their Central States pod was not awarded a team for their birth year. This left the appeals of Mueller, Blankenship and Bezzole to consider.

After the meeting was called to order, but before any appeals were heard, a motion was made by Dave Sivcovich that we would advise Youth Division that their Central States Rules, as they apply to prior OTT transfers, are inappropriate as they effect prior OTT transfers. YD directed to re-write that portion of their rule in such form as would not affect the right of prior OTT Transfers . Motion seconded by Larry Hellwig.

After discussion the question was called by Pat Culiberk and the motion was passed by a vote of 8-1-3. By way of clarification, this would not apply to OTT transfers this year as they were advised as to the potential rule changes. However Scott Smith (as president of YD) indicated that any parties who were granted OTT transfers this year would be allowed to withdraw their transfer requests if they wished.

The result of this motion is that all 3 of the appeals pending were granted and any others in similar circumstances who did not choose to appeal to the affiliate would also be allowed to participate as a member of their current club with the same rights and privileges as all other club members.
