**Fasting:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, ages 18-59 / **Abstinence:** Every Friday during Lent, ages 14+

**How do we fast?:** When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

**Those excused:** Those outside the age limits include physically or mentally ill, including those suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes, and pregnant or nursing women.
