SSUFC Guidance to Reschedule Games

Option 1: Reschedule using Practice Night

reschedule on your regular practice night. Rescheduled games will be given priority over the shared practice fields. The second team will be asked to relocate to a field at the same soccer complex if available. Alternate practice locations can be located if required.

i.e. The U12 team regularly scheduled to practice on Helliwell Medium #2, moves practice to Helliwell Main #1

2025 Lakeshore Rule Book and Operations Manual – excerpt

11.3. Games may be rescheduled by the mutual consent of the home team coach and the visiting team coach. Reasons for rescheduling may include weather, air quality, school trips and events or conflicts with other sporting events but all reschedules must be approved by the Division Convener and subject to the following guidelines:

- All regular rescheduling, with the exception of weather and air-quality cancellations, must be done at least seven (7) days prior to the game date.
- Reschedules with fewer than seven (7) days until the game may be considered by the Convenor on a case-by-case basis.
- A new game date must be decided upon before the reschedule is permitted.
- A field and referee must be available and booked by the home team coach before the reschedule will be permitted.

Note: Do not postpone the rescheduled game(s) to the end of the season since timing may not allow it to be played.

11.4. Only the referee can cancel play during the game or just prior to the start of the game. Reasons for cancellation can include lightning or heat.

Note: The Home Coach should notify the visiting coach of inclement weather or field closure no later than 5pm on game day.

11.5. If a game is cancelled while in progress, the game must be rescheduled unless:

- It has been played fifteen (15) minutes into the second half, at which time it is considered official, or
- It has been mutually agreed between opposing coaches to call the game at its current standing.

11.6. For cancelled games, both coaches must arrange to reschedule a cancelled game within one week. The Division Convener must be notified by the home team coach.

11.7. If the coaches can not agree on a reschedule date (due to a reschedule request or cancellation) the game will not be played and no points will be awarded for that game.
