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COACHING STAFF

LUCAS TRICKLE - COACH TRICKLE IS BEGINNING HIS SECOND YEAR AS HIGH SCHOOL HEAD COACH AFTER FOUR SEASONS AS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT HENRY SIBLEY HIGH SCHOOL. HE IS A THIEF RIVER FALLS, MN, NATIVE WHERE HE PLAYED A MAJORITY OF HIS YOUTH HOCKEY. HE GRADUATED FROM BALDWIN-WOODVILLE HIGH SCHOOL WHERE HE FINISHED HIS CAREER. HE WAS AN TWO-TIME CAPTAIN AND A TWO-TIME ALL CONFERENCE DEFENSE-MAN. PRIOR TO RE-JOINING THE BALDWIN-WOODVILLE COACHING STAFF, HE COACHED AT HENRY SIBLEY, BALDWIN-WOODVILLE AND MOORHEAD, MN.

MIKE OLSON - COACH OLSON IS BEGINNING HIS FIFTH YEAR AS ASSISTANT COACH AT BALDWIN-WOODVILLE HIGH SCHOOL. HE PLAYED YOUTH AND HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY IN THE BLACKHAWK HOCKEY ASSOCIATION GRADUATING FROM ST. CROIX CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL. PRIOR TO JOINING THE BALDWIN-WOODVILLE COACHING STAFF, HE COACHED AT HENRY SIBLEY HIGH SCHOOL.

ANDY LINDUS - COACH LINDUS HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN THE BLACKHAWK HOCKEY ASSOCIATION AS A COACH FOR THE BETTER PART OF THE LAST TWENTY YEARS. HE WILL BE BEGINNING HIS SEVENTH YEAR AS PART OF THE HIGH SCHOOL COACHING STAFF IN 2019-20. COACH LINDUS' PRIMARY DUTIES ARE WORKING WITH GOALTENDERS AS WELL AS HELPING WITH THE FORWARDS.

CRAIG CAMPBELL - COACH CRAIG D. CAMPBELL IS BEGINNING HIS 3RD YEAR AS AN ASSISTANT COACH WITH "THE HAWKS." CRAIG PLAYED HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY FOR THE NORTH ST. PAUL POLARS 1988-1990. PRIOR TO JOINING THE HAWKS STAFF HE COACHED 8 YEARS WITH BLACKHAWK HOCKEY ASSOCIATION MITES - BANTAMS.

JOHNNY SEIBEL- JOHNNY IS A SKILL DEVELOPMENT SPECIALIST WHO FOCUSES ON PROPER TECHNIQUE WHILE SKATING, SHOOTING, PASSING AND PUCK HANDLING. HE HAS WORKED FOR 8 YEARS WITH SCOTT BJUGSTAD (MN WILD SHOOTING COACH) AND 4 YEARS WITH DIANE AND ANDY NESS (MN WILD SKATING AND SKILLS COACHES). OVER HIS TIME AS A SKILL DEVELOPMENT COACH, HE HAS WORKED WITH YOUTH, HIGH SCHOOL, COLLEGE, AND PROFESSIONAL HOCKEY PLAYERS, TAKING THEIR GAME TO THE NEXT LEVEL.

BRANDON CONNETT- BRANDON IS THE PROGRAM'S ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER WITH 218 CAREER POINTS. DURING HIS TIME AS A HAWK, BRANDON WAN AN ALL STATE SELECTION TWICE AND PLAYED FOR TEAM WISCONSIN. HE IS CURRENTLY PLAYING FOR THE ALEXANDRIA BLIZZARD IN THE NA3HL.

JAKE CARLSON- JAKE JUST FINISHED HIS DECORATED CAREER AS A HAWK. HE FINISHED HIS CAREER AS THE PROGRAM'S FIFTH ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER AND WAS AN ALL CONFERENCE SELECTION TWICE. JAKE PLANS TO CONTINUE PLAYING HOCKEY AT THE NEXT LEVEL NEXT YEAR.
