Wildcats Storylines ...

FOR ALL THE MARBLES: The Wildcats' playoff hopes rest on Saturday's game. With a win, the Wildcats have about a 76% chance of making the playoffs, according to Drew Pasteur. With a loss, the Wildcats' odds of staying in the playoff hunt drop to 1%. Expect the Wildcats to come out with a fiery desire to stay alive for a playoff spot.

BACK TO BYERS: The Wildcats have not seen much of Byers Field this season. Saturday's game marks just the third home contest of the season. The Wildcats are 1-1 in Parma this season.

GCL FOES: The Wildcats are no stranger to the Bombers and the Greater Catholic League (GCL) South. Last year, the Wildcats finished 3-0 against GCL foes Moeller, Elder, and St. Xavier. In the Wildcats' trip to Cincy last week, Saint Ignatius dominated Archbishop Moeller, 38-7.

GRIFFIN'S ARMY: Quarterback Griffin Hanna has enjoyed a nice season. On the year, Hanna has 1,813 yards and 15 touchdowns through the air, along with 61 yards and 5 touchdowns on the ground. Hanna needs just 187 passing yards to become a member of the 2,000 passing yard club. Under Offensive Coordinator Nick Restifo Hon. 19, a total of 16 QBs have reached 2,000 yards passing in a season. Hanna is 367 yards from cracking Top 10 all-time for passing yards in a season. Joe Pickens (2,180, 1988) is at No. 10.

MILESTONE WATCH: After serving as the second option in 2018, Jack Welcsh has been the bellcow this year. Welcsh is approaching 1,000 career rushing yards (350 in 2018, 500 in 2019). Welcsh tabbed his 10th career rushing TD on Saturday. Connor Cmiel is 186 yards from 1,500 career receiving yards (830 in 2018, 484 in 2019).

BALANCED ATTACK: The Wildcats will look to employ a balanced approach on Saturday vs. St. Xavier. On the year, the Wildcats have been almost perfectly balanced, with 231 rushes and 215 passes.

THE BIG UGLIES: The Wildcats' linemen will be important on both sides of the ball on Saturday. Nick Schwitzgebel and Tony Georges have anchored the line as veteran tackles on offense. Ashton Montgomery, Gus Salopek, and Owen Keane have also been great on the O-Line. Griffin Hanna has been sacked just 10 times in 8 games. On defense, Bennett Adler continues to thrive, with 17.5 tackles, 7.5 tackles for loss (T-1st), and 4.5 sacks (1st).

THE LEGION: The strength of the defense has been the linebacker legion this season. Aidan Hubbard leads all tacklers with 34.5 tackles and is tied for the lead with 7.5 TFL. Connor Francz is third on the squad with 27.5 tackles. In just 4 games, Michael McNamara has 18 tackles and 5 TFL.

DAUG CHECK: The Wildcats' secondary has played quite well, with perhaps Erik Daugenti shining brightest. Daugenti is often responsible for single coverage on the outside, a role he relishes. Daugenti has 24 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss, 7 pass breakups (1st), and an interception. Speaking of Daugs, TE Sam Daugstrup committed to Indiana University this week.

CAPTAINS: The four captains for the 2019 season are #10 Griffin Hanna, #34 Jack Welcsh, #44 Michael McNamara, and #71 Nick Schwitzgebel.

ABOUT ST. XAVIER ...

Learning about the Bombers ...

SHIPPING UP TO CLEVELAND: Every two years, the Bombers trek to Cleveland to face the Wildcats. St. Xavier has lost the last two road games to the Wildcats, both at Byers Field. All-time, St. Xavier is 4-2 against the Wildcats at Byers, with three of the four wins decided by three or fewer points.

MATTHEW'S MEN: Matthew Rueve helms the offense for St. Xavier. The senior is enjoying a heck of a year, his first as the starter. Rueve has 2,103 passing yards, 21 touchdowns, and 3 interceptions, completing 65.5% of his passes. Rueve is a steady quarterback who is masterful in the short-to-intermediate passing attack. The 6'4, 190-pound signalcaller is excellent throwing into tight windows, but he can also loft it deep. Rueve is also captable of running.

NEWMAN ATTACK: Kellen Newman is the primary St. Xavier running back. The senior is a solid option in the backfield, with 526 yards and 6 TD's. The Bombers imagine creative ways to get him the ball, with counters, reverses, and cutback runs. Look for Newman to carry it in the Wildcat near the goal line.

FORMATION FRENZY: The Bombers use a wide number of formations on offense. St. Xavier will line up in shotgun, the pistol, Power I, Ace (singeback). In doing so, St. Xavier hopes to keep defenses guessing with what's coming next.

WIDEOUTS TO WATCH: Tight end Marshall Lang and wideout Liam Clifford are the Bombers' top two passcatchers. Lang tops the team with 60 catches, while Clifford leads the way with 866 yards and 9 TD's. This week, Clifford followed in his the footsteps of his brother, Sean, by committing to Penn State. Other wideouts to keep an eye on are Owen Smith (18 receptions, 233 yards, 2 TD's) and Andrew Britt (17 catches, 131 yards, 1 TD).

GAMBLERS: The Bombers are not afraid to go for it on fourth down. St. Xavier have completed 11-of-23 fourth-down conversions. Last week, St. Xavier went for it on 4th and 1 from their own 24-yard line in the first quarter.

DEFENSIVE SCHEMING: St. Xavier's defense looks a lot like the Wildcats' 3-3 scheme. The Bombers' stack defense is slightly different, with unique blitzes and other wrinkles. St. Xavier likes to play man coverage, mixing in the occasional zone. Blitzes are common.

DEFENSIVE PLAYMAKERS: One could argue that St. Xavier's strong-suit is its secondary. The Bombers have three seniors starting in the secondary, including free safety Tucker Hundley (37.5 tackles, 6 tackles for loss). But St. Xavier's linebackers and line are also quite good. Linebackers Matthew Devine and Noah Taylor are tied for the lead in tackles with 38 apiece. Devine also has a team-best 10.5 TFL and 4 sacks.

KICKING DUTIES: Mason Rohmiller and Joe Sullivan split kicking duties, with a combined 4-of-9 field goals. Noah Taylor is the punter.



St. Xavier's 3-3 stack will be a test, and Georges will be crucial to helping the Cats pass.

CB ERIK DAUGENTI '20



With Connor Cmiel out last week, Erik Daugenti stepped up at cornerback. Moeller struggled to pass the ball, in part because of Daugenti's excellent coverage. The senior tops the team with 7 passes defensed this season. Daugenti has been a lockdown corner all year, often charged with shutting down a wideout in 1-on-1 coverage. Daugenti will be key to stopping the Bombers' wideouts.

GAME PREVIEW

PLAYOFF HOPES ON THE LINE IN WEEK 9 VS. BOMBERSS

It all comes down to this game for the Saint Ignatius football team.

Win, and the Wildcats' hopes of a playoff berth stay alive.

Lose, and the season ends on November 2 after the regular season finale vs. West Toronto Prep.

St. Xavier will not take it easy on the Wildcats. The Bombers enter with a 6-2 record, with wins over prominent foes. LaSalle handed St. Xavier a loss last week, but the Bombers still clinched a playoff spot.

Saint Ignatius and St. Xavier have played 26 games all-time, with the series tied at 13-13. The two schools have played in the regular season for 20 straight seasons. The Wildcats have won the last four regular season games dating back to 2015.

This season's game should be thrilling, as always.

SAINT IGNATIUS OFFENSE VS. ST. XAVIER DEFENSE

Under quarterback Griffin Hanna, the Wildcats' offense is humming. Through the air Hanna has 1,813 yards and 15 touchdowns, along with 5 rushing TD's. Hanna tallied 4 TD's vs. Moeller in a big win. Hanna is just 187 yards from becoming the 17th QB under Offensive Coordinator Nick Restifo Hon. 19 to reach 2,000 yards passing in a season.

One of his best weapons, Connor Cmiel, missed last week. The Wildcats are hoping to have him back on Saturday. The senior wideout has 22 catches for 484 yards and 4 TD's.

Jake Lang and Henry Cook are also dangerous options in the passing game. Each receiver has 27 catches and over 400 yards. Cook leads the team with 7 receiving TD's on the year.

Jack Welcsh has emerged as the lead option at running back. The senior's bruising style can wear down defenses, as Welcsh has 500 yards and 5 TD's on the season. James Crosby is another solid option in the backfield as a quick, fast back.

The offensive line has been exceptional this year, and they'll need another big day vs. St. Xavier.

The Bombers play a 3-3-5 defense, not unlike the Wildcats' scheme. St. Xavier's defense has its own twists, with disguised blitzes and unique plays.

In the secondary, St. Xavier likes to play man coverage, but they'll mix in some zone. With lots of experience in the secondary, the Bombers aren't afraid to blitz and leave the cornerbacks on an island.

The Bombers have no lack of playmakers on defense. Linebackers Matthew Devine and Noah Taylor are tied for the lead in tackles with 38 apiece. Devine also has a team-best 10.5 TFL and 4 sacks. Both are very stout against the run and in attacking the QB. The secondary may be the defense's strength, with three senior starters, including Tucker Hundley.

SAINT IGNATIUS DEFENSE VS. ST. XAVIER OFFENSE

To state the obvious, the St. Xavier offense is quite good. The Bombers average 31.4 points per game, with a wide range of playmakers and ways to attack opposing defenses.

In a departure from recent seasons, the Bombers will not line up almost exclusively in shotgun. St. Xavier uses many different formations, from Ace (singleback) to pistol to I-formation to shotgun. The Bombers line up in a wide range of ways to confuse opposing defenses.

Matthew Rueve helms the offense as the quarter-back. The 6'4, 190-pound senior has great stats, with 2,103 yards, 21 TD, and just 3 interceptions. Rueve is exceptional in the short-to-intermediate passing game, with a knack for throwing into small windows. Rueve gets the ball out of his hand quickly, negating big blitzes. Rueve also has the arm to send long passes deep.

Tight end Marshall Lang and wideout Liam Clifford are his primary targets. Lang has 60 receptions for 654 yards and 7 TD's and Clifford has 59 catches for 866 yards and 9 TD's. This week, Clifford followed in his brother Sean's footsteps, committing to Penn State University. Other wideouts to watch are Owen Smith (18 receptions, 233 yards, 2 TD's) and Andrew Britt (17 catches, 131 yards, 1 TD).

Kellen Newman is the bellcow of the offense. The senior has 110 rushes for 526 yards and 6 TD's on the season. The 5'8, 184-pound senior is a speedy back with elusive moves.

Size-wise, the Bombers' line is not the biggest the Wildcats have seen this season. But the Bombers' linemen are quick and work well in this offense, with frequent misdirections, counters, and reverses.

The Wildcats' 3-3-5 defense has been on fire lately, allowing 21 points over the last three games. Aidan Hubbard and Michael McNamara have been exceptional at linebacker. Anthony Gerace, Bennett Adler, and Max Watters are all in a groove at defensive line. And the secondary is thriving, with players mixing in and out.

As a unit, the Wildcats need be smart against this tricky Bombers' offense.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Special teams often play a factor in Saint Ignatius vs. St. Xavier games. Each team is very good in this area. Declan Mangan and Rory McConville have done well kicking for the Cats. Mason Rohmiller and Joe Sullivan split kicking duties for the Bombers. Noah Taylor is the punter.

MOELLER RECAP

WILDCATS ROLL PAST MOELLER IN IMPRESSIVE FASHION

From the opening drive, the Saint Ignatius defense played smashmouth, hard-nosed football. Moeller punted quickly in its opening drive. After Saint Ignatius also stalled on its first possession, the men of Ryan Franzinger '02 again showed no mercy on Moeller's second time with the ball.

The Wildcats' offense came alive on its second drive. On a 3rd and long, Griffin Hanna rolled out of the pocket. Looking for options on the nearside, Hanna saw Henry Cook come open. Hanna lofted a perfect pass over the arms of the defensive back and into Henry Cook's hands. The senior wideout did the rest, galloping untouched for the opening score, 65 yards in all. Rory McConville nailed the extra point for the 7-0 lead.

All season, the Crusaders have struggled with turnovers. The team's turnover woes led to another Saint Ignatius strike. Aidan Crummie picked off a Moeller pass on third down, setting the Wildcats up at the Crusaders' 40-yard line. Three plays later on 3rd and 15, Hanna again looked to pass. This time, the senior saw Jake Lang come open. Hanna tossed the ball short across the middle to his big tight end, and the baseball and football star took it from there. Lang dodged tacklers en route to a 45-yard score and a 14-0 lead for the Wildcats.

The Saint Ignatius quickstrike offense pulled out another trick after a quick Moeller three-and-out. On the first play of the drive, Cook came open again. The star athlete caught Moeller in a zone coverage with a slant across the middle. Once Hanna got him the ball, Cook jetted through the defense and all the way to the end zone for a 56-yard score.

In the blink of an eye, the Wildcats held a 21-0 lead. The advantage stayed at 21 points until the Crusaders scored their lone points of the day early in the second quarter.

On a nice run, Bryan White found a seam in the Saint Ignatius defense. The Moeller speedster raced the rest of the way to paydirt on a 55-yard scamper.

With the lead dwindled to 14 points, the Wildcats' quickstrike offense took a more methodical approach. Pounding Moeller with the run, the Cats used 5:13 to march 64 yards in 13 plays. Unfortunately, the drive went for naught, as Moeller blocked a 33-yard field goal attempt.

Enter Aidan Crummie. On Moeller's first play, the Crusaders fumbled a handoff. Crummie leaped at the opportunity, launching himself to recover the fumble in the backfield. His second turnover of the day placed the Wildcats in great field position.

A holding call and a sack set the Cats back, so Saint Ignatius trotted out the field goal team. This time, the field goal reached higher than Moeller's defenders, but just missed the goal posts wide right from 45 yards.

Even so, the Wildcats were not rattled. The defense forced a quick three-and-out, giving the ball back to Hanna and Co. Near midfield with 2:20 left, the Wildcats used a methodical approach in moving downfield while draining clock. Two Hanna passes and four Jack Welcsh runs set the Wildcats up at the Moeller 2-yard line. After a timeout, Hanna plowed into the end zone for six, with Rory McConville finishing things off with a PAT

Entering the break, the Wildcats held a commanding 28-7 lead.

The teams traded punts to start the third quarter before the Wildcats killed any hopes of a home team comeback.

On a 9-play, 60-yard drive that heavily featured Jack Welcsh, the Saint Ignatius offensive line pounded Moeller's front seven into dust. In a drive that certainly made Paul Yappel and Adam Rini '99 happy, the offensive line worked as a hammer, opening lanes for Welcsh and taking a pound of flesh while doing so.

Welcsh carried the ball on 7 of the 9 plays, including the decisive 4-yard rushing score. McConville converted his fifth extra point of the day, and the Wildcats were in full control, 35-7.

The running clock began midway through the fourth quarter. A couple of Hanna passes and a dose of James Crosby pushed the Wildcats ahead. The drive stopped at the Moeller 4-yard line, but McConville converted from 27 yards for the final points of the day.

The Wildcats' backups then entered, sealing the win on a beautiful Cincinnati day.

The Crusaders are having a difficult year at 1-7, one of the program's worst in recent memory. But Saint Ignatius Head Coach Chuck Kyle '69 talked with first-year coach Todd Naumann after the game and had good words to say about Moeller's future.

Looking at the stats, the Wildcats dominated in all aspects. Hanna tallied 296 passing yards vs. just 27 for Moeller. Led by Welcsh's 17-carry, 75-yard day, the Wildcats outgained the Crusaders on the ground, 109-70. Take away White's 55-yard TD, and Moeller gained just 42 yards on 38 plays.

Kudos goes to the Saint Ignatius passcatchers in Connor Cmiel's absence. Lang hauled in 7 passes for 110 yards, while Cook caught 4 passes for 153 yards.

The Wildcats' defense played just as well, limiting Moeller to 97 yards on 39 plays. Connor Francz topped the team with 4.5 tackles, 1 sack, and 1 tackle for loss. Reigning Magis Athlete of the Week Max Watters did well again, with 3 tackles, 1 sack, and 2 tackles for loss. Crummie also deserves praise for his interception and fumble recovery.

2018 marks the 91st season that football has been played on this location; now known as Byers Field at Robert M. Boulton Stadium.

In 1921, the cities of Parma and Parma Heights opened the first high school for their residents on a site just outside the east bleachers. Seven years later, the apple orchard and grass field located behind the new school was converted into the athletic field with the gridiron laid out in a north-south alignment, just as it is today.

Recently, renovations have been completed on the facility.

In the last decade, a new lighting system was installed; bleacher improvements (including the installation of handrails) were completed along with renovations to the lockerrooms, restrooms and concession areas

Other improvements include the installation of a video board at the north end of the stadium - it is one of the largest video boards in use at a high school facility the state.

The pressbox, which has been upgraded in the past five seasons with a new working media area and new windows, seats 30 journalists and broadcasters.

New field turf was installed for the 2012 season. In the last two seasons, the stadium has also had handicap seating added to both sets of grandstands, including 46 wheelchair and companion seats on the home side of the stadium.

The Parma City Schools invested nearly \$1.2 million into the facilty during the summer of 2014, including a new parking lot on the south end of the Stadium and the full replacement of the parking lot on the east side of the stadium, under the Press Box.

Wildcats clinch playoff spot with comeback victory over St. Xavier

CINCINNATI - The Saint Ignatius Wildcats overcame a double-digit deficit to earn a 27-20 victory over the St. Xavier Bombers. The Bombers used the Wildcats' early struggles to build leads of 13-3 and 20-10. But the Saint Ignatius defense and the Wildcats' offense won the day.

Following a Pat Otter punt, St. Xavier took possession at the 3-yard line. The Bombers picked up four yards on the first play of the drive before Wyatt Hudepohl tossed it to running back Chris Payne who ran for a 93-yard touchdown. The Bombers missed the extra point, setting the score at 6-0 St. Xavier with 7:06 left in the first quarter. An unsuccessful Wildcats possession sent the ball back to the Bombers. The Saint Ignatius defense notched its second of three turnovers in the first half. Chris Velotta Jr. intercepted a pass, returning it to the St. Xavier 26-yard line. The Wildcats could not find the end zone, but Rory McConville converted a 35-yard field goal, narrowed the deficit to 6-3.

The teams exchanged possessions before the Bombers drove the field in the final minutes of the half. On the eighth play of the drive, Hudepohl lofted a 16-yard touchdown pass to Marshall Lang for a touchdown. Joe Sullivan's PAT sent the lead to double digits, 13-3. In the final 50 seconds of the half, the Wildcats drove to the end zone. Patrick Delahunty orchestrated a 6-play, 54-yard march. Connor Cmiel hauled in a 14-yard touchdown to complete the drive. McConville hit the extra point, leaving the score at 13-10 Bombers at the half.

On the first drive of the quarter, Hudepohl led a 7-play, 68-yard drive down the field. Clifford capped off the drive with a catch in end zone from Hudepohl. The touchdown and extra point extended the St. Xavier lead to 20-10. Floyd and Delahunty started a march with runs of 16 and 15 yards. Cmiel caught a 54-yard touchdown pass from Dalahunty that completely turned the momentum of the game with 6:52 left in the third quarter. With 2:56 left in the third quarter, Delahunty found Nate Conry for 10 and Cmiel for 36, Delahunty led the Wildcats to the Bombers' 23-yard line by the end of the third quarter. But the Bombers held strong, forcing a McConville 37-yarder to knot the score at 20.

The Wildcats' defense forced a three-and-out before the Saint Ignatius offense took control of the game. Floyd ran on four straight plays to begin the drive. Delahunty completed a 6-yard pass to Cmiel before Floyd ran twice for 4 yards. Delahunty found Cmiel for 35-yards to the 1-yard line. Three plays later, Delahunty hit Aidan Wells for a 4-yard touchdown with 4:17 left.

From there, the Wildcats' defense held off St. Xavier to seal the road win.


