

Substitution Request Rules:

SUBSTITUTIONS (if team falls below 9 players)

This is the process and procedure for subs.

1. Notify your division commissioner that you need a sub in your division GroupMe. (ex @scotthenderson I need a sub)
2. The division commissioner and the player agent will coordinate a sub for you from the preapproved list. You need to take a poll 3 to 4 days out to see if you will be missing any players.
3. Wait for the information on your sub. Contact the subs parents to relay game information.

SUBS HAVE TO BE FROM THE APPROVED LIST

SUBS ARE ROTATED IN ORDER

THEY SHOULD NOT PLAY FOR

THE SAME TEAM CONSECUTIVELY

SUBS MUST BE WITHIN ONE LA OF THE DIVISION THEY WILL SUB IN.

SUBS COME FROM 1 DIVISION BELLOW

SUBS BAT LAST IN THE ORDER

SUBS MUST PLAY 6 CONSECUTIVE OUTS IN THE FIELD

SUBS DO NOT PITCH

SUBS WILL NOT PLAY MORE THAN THE ROSTER-ED PLAYERS ON A TEAM

MANAGERS CANNOT PICK THEIR SUBS

EMERGENCY SUBS THE DAY OFF A GAME

If a sub is needed at the last minute, these are the rules. Subs

1. Sub needs to be from a lower division or can be a player from the same division that

graded (not drafted) 5th round or lower.

2. Same sub cannot be used by a team in consecutive games.
3. No subs will be granted unless a team falls below 9 players.
4. Emergency sub will bat last and play right field only.
5. Player agent and/or division commissioner must approve the sub.

**PLAYERS FROM A HIGHER DIVISION CAN NEVER BE USED AS A SUB
REGARDLESS OF LEAGUE AGE**

Remember if you receive a substitute and your 9th rostered player shows up. You must start your rostered player over the substitute. The substitute can still field and bat honoring the above rules.
