### **CBA Ice Update:**

- Taking down the “no spectators sign” as it has been confusing
- Sending out a reminder to coaches to make sure locker rooms are clean after each use
- Masks are in the desk if anyone needs one
- Could use wheel washes for the Zamboni
- Zamboni is from 1994- should be time to upgrade soon “new-used” is around \$40-\$45K

### **Physical Therapy partnership:**

- Partnering with Peter Clark at “Beyond Strength”
- Every Monday from 3pm to 5pm CBHA athletes can schedule free sports injury evaluations
- Can also get referrals to physicians

### **Raffle ticket sales:**

- Almost 16K in sales (400 transactions), keeping sales open throughout December
- Goal for 2022 is 20K

### **Goalie Tuition for 22'-23':**

- Looking at a 25-30% discount for goalies for next season
- Up to 35% for goalies that are on “two goalie” teams
- Board will take a vote in the new year

### **Maine Mariners partnership:**

- May need to start cutting back on giving out free tickets soon.. make sure we have enough for the remainder of the season (stars of the week, youth hockey night)
