Limit in-game cheering to encouragement. Do not shout instruction.



When things get heated – a cooling off period can be good

 In an effort to ensure a fun yet competitive atmosphere for all players, coaches and parents, we ask all families to follow these guidelines to resolve issues. We also ask that all issues be communicated AFTER a 24 hour cooling off period.

Resolution Escalation

Player communicates issue to Coach.
Player & parent schedule a meeting with the coach.
Player, parent and coach schedule a meeting with Jr/Sr House Director.
Player, parent, coach, and Director schedule a meeting with Commissioner.
Baseball Commissioner schedules a meeting with ARAA president for final resolution.
