

All-Star Parent / Player Code of Conduct

PURPOSE: In an effort to minimize parental/player misunderstandings, please carefully read the following contract and sign acknowledging you understand the policies, rules and regulations.

1. As parent and player, we acknowledge that being a CSA All-Star DOES NOT require EQUAL playing time. Fair and reasonable playing time is encouraged. Player positions and playing time will be decided by the team manager at his/her discretion.
2. Because of the higher competitive nature of CSA All-Stars, players are required to make a full commitment to attending both practices and tournaments on-time and with a positive attitude.
3. As parent and player, we agree to be courteous and respectful at all times to all persons. We will exercise self-control in interactions with others both on and off the field.
4. As a parent, I agree to follow the rules and regulations concerning alcohol possession and consumption per tournament rules and local jurisdiction. I understand that breaking tournament rules concerning alcohol can lead to consequences implemented by the tournament directors, including the ejection of the team from the tournament.
5. As a player, I understand that I represent CSA Softball, my team, and my coaches. I will enhance our reputation and character with my conduct on and off the field. I will respect and protect the equipment and facilities where I practice and play games whether in Carlsbad or outside of Carlsbad.
6. As parent and player, we will accept constructive criticism from managers and coaches in a POSITIVE way. I will demonstrate a POSITIVE attitude and show RESPECT toward teammates, team manager, coaches, opponents and spectators.
7. As parent and player, we will show RESPECT for game officials and their decisions. We will apply the rule of good sportsmanship and accept, respect, and abide by the decisions made by the officials at all times. We commit to making good sportsmanship a top priority and will model winning with class and tolerating defeat with dignity.
8. As a parent, I will accept the responsibility of supporting my team manager and coaches in creating a POSITIVE and SAFE environment for all players at all times.

9. As a player, I understand and accept my role on the team as a player/competitor, not a coach. As a parent, I understand and respect the differences between parental roles and coaching roles and agree to uphold the authority of officials and team manager and coaches who are working with my child.

10. As parent and player, we understand that we have the right to have a conversation with the team manager if any issues or concerns arise. We will engage in the conversation in a POSITIVE and RESPECTFUL manner. We acknowledge the appropriate time for such conversation is not during a practice or game.

11. As parent and player, we understand that failure to abide by this contract will result in disciplinary actions as it seems appropriate to the team manager and/or CSA Board. Such disciplinary actions may include:
 - a. The offending party may be asked by the team manager or a Board member to leave the premises.
 - b. Suspension from attending or coaching one or multiple games or practices, as determined by the CSA Board.
 - c. Any other disciplinary action felt to be reasonable as determined by the CSA Board.
