 - 14 minute stop times for the Chan/EP challenge.
- IV. Chanhasen Winter Storm Classic 2022 Update – Mary (10 mins)
 - Stacy sent over a signup to Corey and Kayla for their players to get involved.
 - Need to indicate what color jersey for home teams (top team is light color jersey).
 - Everything is going well.
 - Stacy is going a great job. Has the template ready to go.
 - 175 volunteer shifts. 173 people.
 - Will prioritize championship games at higher grades at Chanhasen High School on the hardwood courts.
 - 275 total teams are registered.
 - We have 9 sponsors for the tournament – updated on the site.
 - Goal is to have the schedule ready by December 1st.
 - Last year on concessions - \$21K in revenue, \$11k in expenses.
 - Where possible, try to make it just one day for teams. Will do two days if needed (12 team brackets).
 - Single day can help with championship game placement on the hardwood court.
 - Mary to reach out to Key Club and National Honor Society for additional volunteers. This could possibly alleviate having assistant coaches having to volunteer.
 - We still need 5 teams to fill the tournament (boys/girls). Mary to reach out to Jason and Karl to see if they can help find teams.

- Mary –
 - Positive feedback on boys coaches clinic.
 - Suggestion to look at having another coaches clinic more midseason (Jan/Feb).
- Alicia –
 - Tournament made \$75.7k last year (\$153.4k in income, \$77.7 in expenses).
 - Fiscal year completed on September 30th.
 - See presentation that was emailed out.
- Jason –
 - Have Rochester coming up this weekend.
 - Overall had a .588 winning % in Chaska last weekend.
- Karl –
 - Lot of competitive games in Prior Lake this weekend.
- Ethan –
 - Chaotic couple of weeks for community league.
 - Had a difficult time finding coaches – have now filled all the coaching vacancies though.
 - Next focus is getting the refs trained and jerseys distributed.
- Shaun –
 - CCFA office tentatively reserved for December and January as well.
 - We could change the cadence to 3rd Sunday (vs 2nd Sunday), and if so, we could possibly have the meetings at the Legion. ERIC to talk to the Legion.
 - Sporfie – can have Rick come back in January to talk to us about how to better leverage the platform (sponsorships).
 - Uniforms – will get more direction in the next 48 hours.

 - Will setup time with Ethan to get him up to speed on communication/groups.
