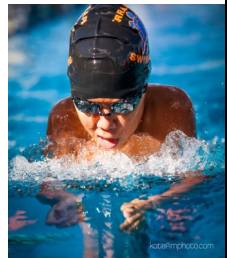
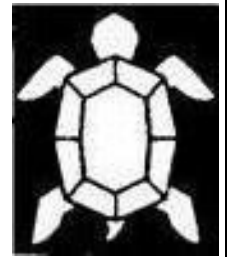
Price/Cost:
