

## RHA PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

We at RHA pride ourselves on being hardworking, disciplined and a program built on character. We hold ourselves to a high standard, this is also for our parents in the program. Please read the following and sign.

- 1. As a parent, I will not encourage my child, or any person, to engage in inappropriate conduct with any coach, opposing coach, parent, player or official.
- 2. As a parent, I will not engage in any behavior which could endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any coach, opposing coach, parent, player or official.
- 3. As a parent, I will not permit my child to use drugs or alcohol at any time they are in this program.
- 4. As a parent, I will encourage my child to treat everyone with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, or sexual orientation.
- 5. As a parent, I will not discuss playing time with any coach in the program without the player first approaching the coach to see what the player can do to improve his/her skills to earn playing time. No parent is to approach a coach with a grievance after a contest. The parent shall wait 24 hours before approaching the coach. A parent shall never discuss another player's actions with a coach.
- 6. As a parent, I will not be negative towards players, parents, opponents or officials on any social media platforms and team messaging.
- 7. As a parent I will always represent RHA in a positive manner when traveling and wearing the RHA logo.
- 8. As a parent I agree to supervise my children when they are at the Thunderdome. I will be responsible for damage intentionally caused by unsupervised children.
