

Listed below are the top-rated teams that competed in the 2024-2025 Great Northwest season. We list 32 teams each for grades 6, 7 and 8 for purposes of determining who will be invited to the 2025-2026 League Championship Tournament (LCT). Our ratings work on a formula basis, like college basketball's RPI or college football's Bowl Coalition rating system. You will note that some teams are rated behind teams they defeated or rated ahead of teams to which they lost. It is consistency during the season against strong competition that determines the final ratings. The ratings formula awards teams points for defeating A or B+ teams and takes points away for losing to teams rated B or lower. It is virtually impossible for a team to be in the Top 32 that does not regularly play A or B+ teams. The number of games won is relevant only if achieved against highly competitive teams.

If you coach a team that we rated "B" and you want the opportunity to move up in the rankings because you think your team can compete at that level, consider registering as a "B+" team for the 2025-2026 season. Wisconsin-based teams that are invited to the Wisconsin State Invitational Championship Tournament, but decline, miss an opportunity to show that they can compete at the highest level and therefore the opportunity to move up in the rankings. Note also Paragraph B-11 in League rules: "Teams that fail to play at least three meets during the 2024-2025 season, or who declined to play in the most recent LCT and offer no legitimate excuse for doing so, will not be included in this season's year-end rankings of Top 32 teams at each grade level."

Teams that dropped in the rankings from the season before shouldn't feel they have regressed. At each grade level, we added teams for the 2024-2025 season. Many of these teams were rated at the B+ level or higher, making it more difficult to make the Top 32. Also, since one or more teams at each grade level may decline their invitation to attend the LCT because of conflicts, some teams not listed in this original Top 32 ranking will likely be included in the final LCT field at most grade levels.
