Player Code of Conduct

- The player will understand the rules of basketball, as well as HYBA, and abide by them.
- The player is expected to respect the game officials and refrain from addressing them or commenting on their decisions during the play of the game.
- The player is expected to maintain control of his/her emotions, avoiding the use of abusive language or profanity, humiliating remarks, and/or gestures of ill temper, and physical assault upon another player at any time.
- The player is expected to respect the coaches and players of the opposing team and demonstrate appropriate gestures of sportsmanship after the game – be humble and generous in victory and proud and courteous in defeat.
- The player is expected to follow all building rules and regulations, respecting at all times the property of others.
- The player is expected to do his/her best in school, recognizing scholastic achievement is one of the foundations of HYBA.
- The player is expected to listen, respect, and learn from his/her coaches.
- The player is expected to support and encourage all teammates and members of the HYBA.
- Berating, humiliating or taunting our coaches, participants, or spectators when in attendance at an event or at any other time in a public forum, including social media, will not be tolerated to any degree.
- The HYBA Executive Board will carry out the consequences of not meeting HYBA's expectations. The consequences will be dealt with on an individual basis.
 - 1st Offense: Written Warning
 - 2nd Offense: Will not be allowed to play 1 game
 - 3rd Offense: The player will be required to sit out the rest of the season
 - The HYBA also reserves the right to dismiss a player immediately for any illegal activity.
