



#### Freshman Overview

The 1997-1998 Tiger Freshman wrestling team can be best described in two words; peaks and valleys. As wrestlers these young men are asked to give a 100% effort 100% of the time. With these types of demands there are obviously going to be breakdowns. When this squad was able to send out it's 14 best wrestlers, there was not a freshman wrestling team in the metro east this squad could not overcome.

The 97-98 Tiger squad finished with 5 dual meet victories; three of those victories coming against fellow Southwestern Conference foes Belleville East and West and another being a dominating 80 – 0 victory over local conference rival Collinsville. Although the Tigers finished with three losses, they were to very formidable opponents. Two narrow defeats came at the hands of two consistently powerful Missouri programs, Oakville and Fort Zummwalt South by and average margin of three points and the third to SWC stalwarts Granite City.

In tournament competition the Tigers were very competitive in finishing in the top 4 of all three team tournaments they competed in, bringing home a third place trophy from the 18 team O'Fallon Freshman Invitational and finishing fourth in both the Fort Zummwalt South and Belleville West Tournaments. Individually the Tiger freshman won a total of 14 tournament championships and 71 total medals, while thundering their way to 131 pins.

This goal will not come without hard work and dedication, not only during the wrestling season, but throughout the year. As a coach I can only hope that these young men have realized what skills are needed to succeed at the next level and that they are willing to put forth the effort that is necessary to reach their individual and team goals. Ultimately all the peaks and valleys that this team endured during the winter of 97-98 will be their biggest asset thus far in their wrestling careers. A special thanks goes out to the all the parents who endured four long months of matches, tournaments, practice schedules and every thing else that comes along with being a wrestling parent. Without your support we as coaches could not succeed.

As you freshman took to succeed at the next level, remember that you now have entered yourself into an elite family; You are now a Tiger Wrestler; Be Proud To BE a Tiger!!
